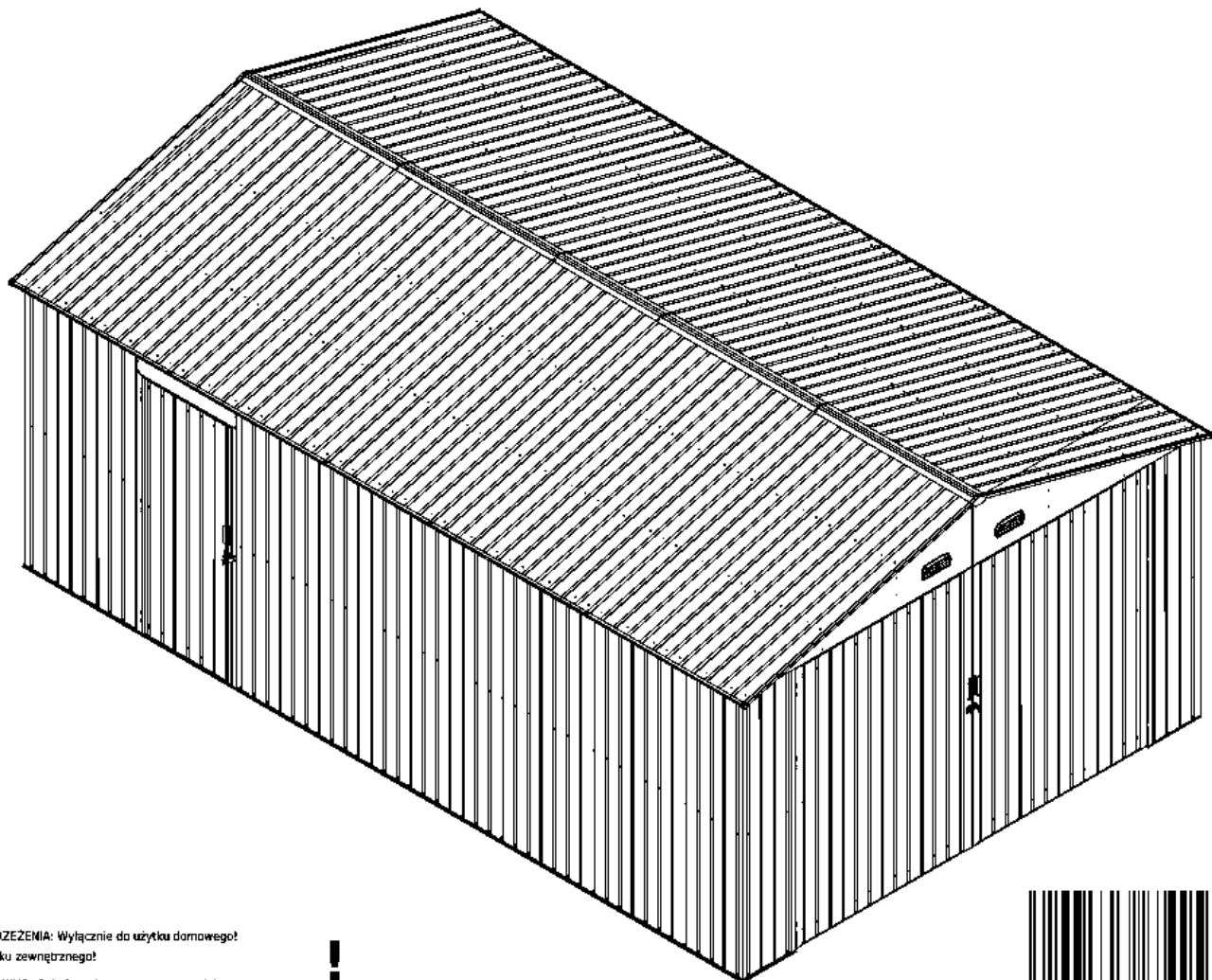

UWAGA:

Produkt jest lekką konstrukcją stalową przeznaczoną do użytkowania zgodnie z instrukcją montażu i użytkowania. W okresie zimowym dach należy regularnie kontrolować i usuwać z niego śnieg po każdym intensywnym opadzie, aby nie dopuścić do nadmiernego obciążenia konstrukcji.

Nie należy dopuszczać do zalegania warstw śniegu, lodu ani innych obciążeń na dachu.

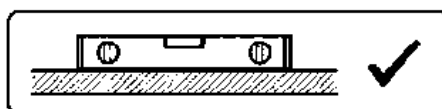
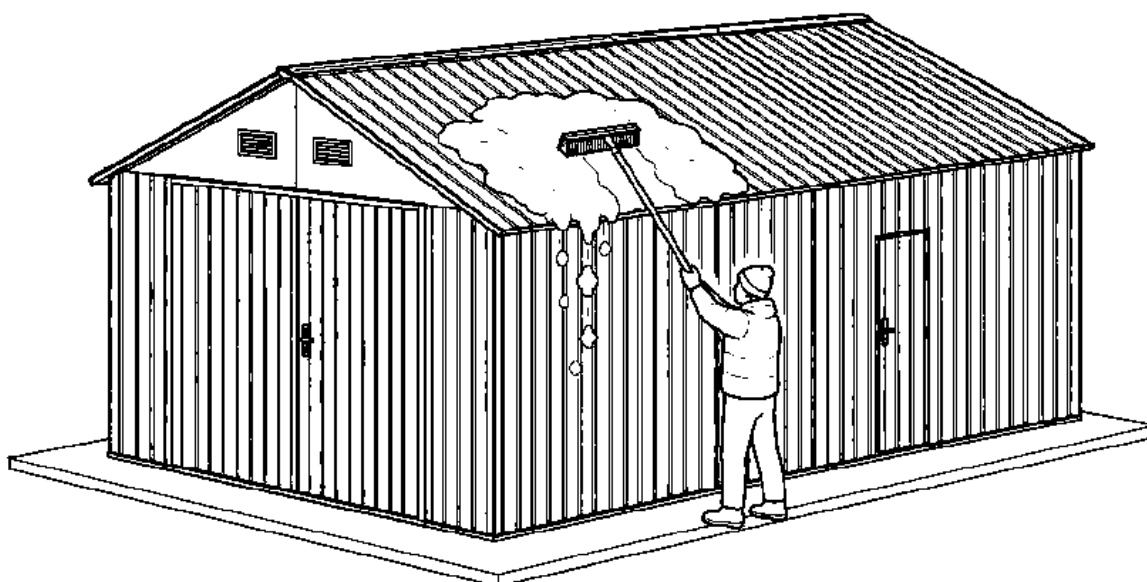
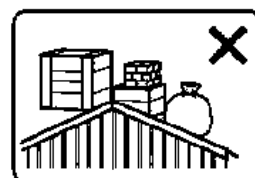
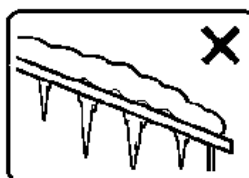
Produkt musi być prawidłowo zakotwiony do odpowiedniego, stabilnego i wypoziomowanego podłoża.

WARNING:

The product is a lightweight steel structure intended to be used in accordance with the assembly and user manual. During winter, the roof must be inspected regularly and snow must be removed after each heavy snowfall to prevent excessive load on the structure.

Do not allow layers of snow, ice, or any other loads to remain on the roof.

PRZYGOTOWANIE DO MONTAŻU

1. Przed rozpoczęciem budowy należy zapoznać się z lokalnymi przepisami budowlanymi dotyczącymi fundamentów, lokalizacji i pozwoleń.
2. Dokładnie przeczytaj całą instrukcję przed rozpoczęciem prac i postępuj zgodnie z kolejnością kroków.
3. Upewnij się, że masz wszystkie niezbędne części i elementy z zestawu.
4. Montaż powinien odbywać się w suchy i bezwietrzny dzień.
5. Zalecany jest montaż zespołowy (minimum 2 osoby). Rekomenduje się zakończenie montażu w ciągu jednego dnia, by nie zostawiać niezmontowanych elementów na działanie warunków pogodowych.
6. Trzymaj dzieci i zwierzęta z dala od miejsca prac.

ŚRODKI BEZPIECZEŃSTWA

1. Noś odzież ochronną: rękawice robocze, okulary ochronne i odzież z długim rękawem.
2. Zachowaj ostrożność – elementy konstrukcyjne mogą mieć ostre krawędzie.
3. Nie opieraj się o konstrukcję podczas montażu.
4. Nie montuj garażu pod wpływem alkoholu, leków ani będąc zmęczonym.
5. Nie stawiaj garażu w miejscu narażonym na silne wiatry bez solidnego zakotwienia.
6. Używając drabiny lub elektronarzędzi, przestrzegaj zasad bezpieczeństwa producenta.
7. Nigdy nie przebywaj wewnątrz garażu podczas burzy, silnego wiatru lub intensywnych opadów śniegu.
8. Nie opieraj całego ciężaru ciała na dachu konstrukcji.
9. W razie śniegu – usuwaj jego nadmiar z dachu, by zapobiec uszkodzeniom.

FUNDAMENT I KOTWIENIE

1. Zalecane podłoże: twarda, równa i wypoziomowana powierzchnia (beton, kostka, drewno, żwir).
2. Sprawdź poziomowanie przekątnych – podstawa musi być dokładnie prostokątna.
3. Połóż folię przeciwwilgociową (min. 150 µm) pod konstrukcją, aby zminimalizować kondensację pary wodnej.
4. Zakotw garaż solidnie do podłoża – zabezpiecz to konstrukcję przed wiatrem.
5. Po zakończeniu montażu zaleca się uszczelnienie silikonem dolnych szyn wewnętrznych.

MONTAŻ - NARZĘDZIA I CZĘŚCI

1. Oddziel i zidentyfikuj wszystkie elementy zgodnie z listą części.
2. Zdejmij ochronne folie z powierzchni przed montażem.
3. Zachowaj etykiety z numerami elementów – mogą być potrzebne w przyszłości.
4. Zestaw może zawierać nadmiarowe śruby i podkładki – są to części zapasowe.
5. Nie montuj konstrukcji, jeśli brakuje jakichkolwiek elementów.

UŻYTKOWANIE I KONSERWACJA

1. Garaż przeznaczony jest wyłącznie do przechowywania – nie nadaje się do zamieszkania.
2. Czyść konstrukcję miękką szmatką z użyciem czystej wody lub łagodnego detergentu.
3. Unikaj silnych środków czyszczących, które mogą uszkodzić powłokę metalu.
4. Regularnie sprawdzaj zawiasy drzwi i w razie potrzeby nasmaruj je odpowiednim środkiem konserwującym.
5. Sprawdzaj okresowo konstrukcję pod kątem stabilności, zwłaszcza po silnych wiatrach lub zimie.

INFORMACJE DODATKOWE

1. Kondensacja: Zmiany temperatury i wilgotności mogą powodować skraplanie się wody wewnątrz – to zjawisko naturalne. Nie oznacza nieszczelności.
2. Ubezpieczenie: Upewnij się, że garaż objęty jest odpowiednim ubezpieczeniem. Zawsze zamykaj drzwi i stosuj klódkę, aby zapobiec kradzieżom.
3. Trwałość: Garaż stalowy jest konstrukcją lekką i tymczasową – nie stanowi trwałego budynku. Wymaga okresowej kontroli i odpowiedniego mocowania.

ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

1. Before starting construction, review local building codes regarding foundation, location, and necessary permits.
2. Carefully read the entire manual before beginning. Follow the step-by-step instructions in the specified order.
3. Make sure you have all required parts and components from the kit.
4. Choose a dry and calm day for assembly.
5. Assembly requires a team of at least two people. It is recommended to complete the assembly within one day.
6. Keep children and pets away from the work area.

SAFETY GUIDELINES

1. Wear protective gear: work gloves, safety glasses, and long-sleeved clothing.
2. Be cautious – some parts may have sharp edges.
3. Do not lean on the structure during assembly.
4. Never assemble the garage while under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or if you are overly tired.
5. Do not place the garage in extremely windy locations without proper anchoring.
6. When using ladders or power tools, follow the manufacturer's safety guidelines.
7. Never stay inside the garage during extreme weather (storms, strong wind, heavy snow).
8. Do not apply full body weight to the roof structure.
9. In snowy conditions, regularly remove snow buildup from the roof to prevent damage.

FOUNDATION AND ANCHORING

1. Recommended base: hard, flat, and level surface (e.g., concrete, paving slabs, wood, or gravel).
2. Use diagonal measurements to ensure the foundation is square.
3. Place a damp-proof plastic sheet (min. 150 µm) under the structure to reduce rising moisture and condensation.
4. Anchor the garage securely to the ground to prevent wind-related damage.
5. Once assembled, apply silicone sealant along the inside of the base rails to reduce condensation.

ASSEMBLY – TOOLS AND COMPONENTS

1. Separate and identify all components according to the parts list before starting.
2. Remove protective film from all surfaces before assembly.
3. Keep the part number labels, as they may be needed for future reference.
4. The kit includes extra screws and washers – these are spares.
5. Do not attempt to assemble the garage if any parts are missing.

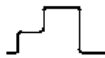
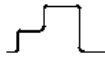
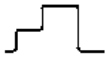
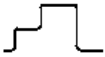
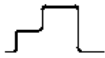
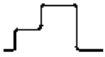
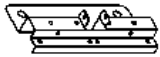
USE AND MAINTENANCE

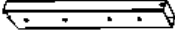
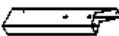
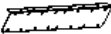
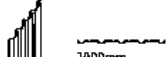
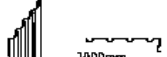
1. This garage is intended for storage purposes only – it is not suitable for habitation.
2. Clean the structure using a soft cloth and water or a mild detergent.
3. Avoid using harsh cleaning chemicals that may damage the metal surface.
4. Regularly check the door hinges and lubricate them if necessary with a suitable maintenance product.
5. Periodically inspect the structure for stability, especially after storms or winter conditions.

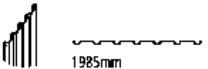
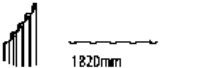
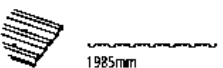
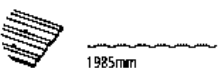
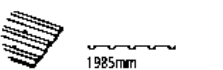
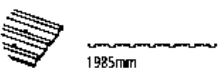
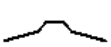
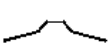
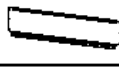
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. Condensation: Temperature changes and air humidity may cause moisture buildup inside the structure – this is normal and not a sign of leakage.
2. Insurance: Ensure the garage is included in your property or content insurance. Always secure the garage with a lock to prevent theft. All garages are lockable, but you must provide the padlock.
3. Durability: Steel garages are considered lightweight, semi-permanent structures. Regular inspections and proper anchoring are necessary for long-term safety and functionality.

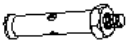
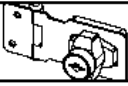
