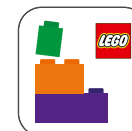




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Building serenity

You can breathe new life into your garden as you move plants to different locations to suit your mood or let them take turns soaking up the sun or cooling down in the shade. You can even move around larger parts of the model to create different shapes and expressions.

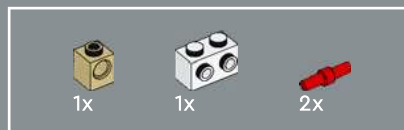
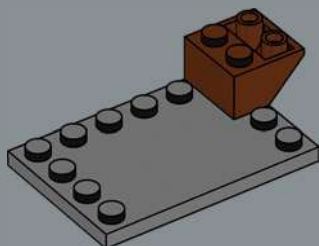
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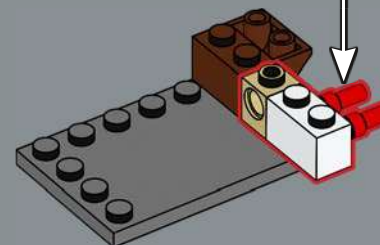
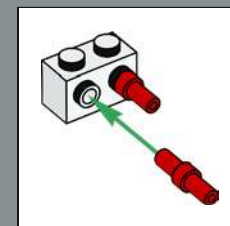
These tiles can be used to create patterns that can be repeated into infinity, which is called tessellation. How many different patterns can you create?



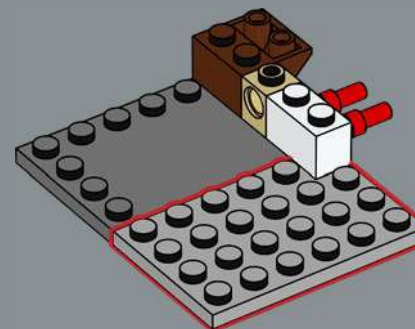
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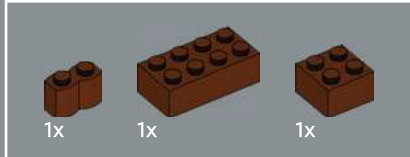
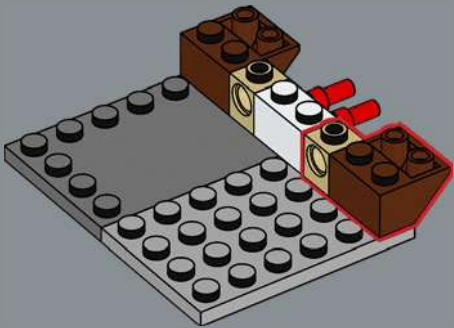


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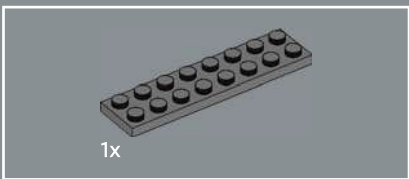
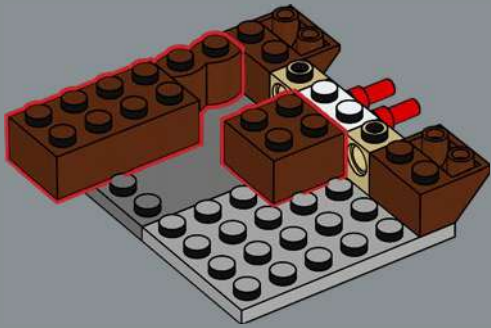




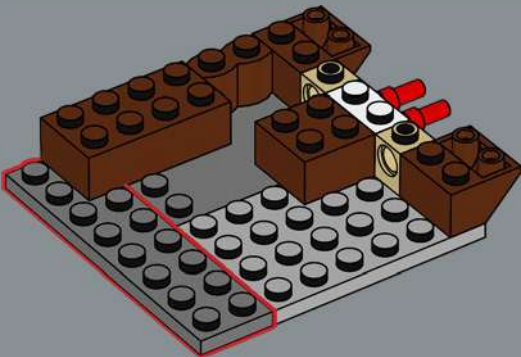
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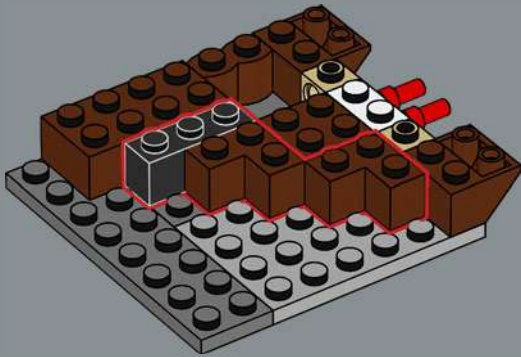
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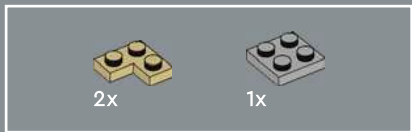


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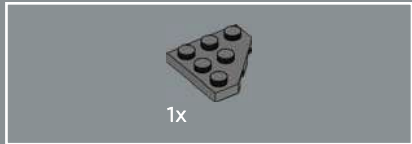
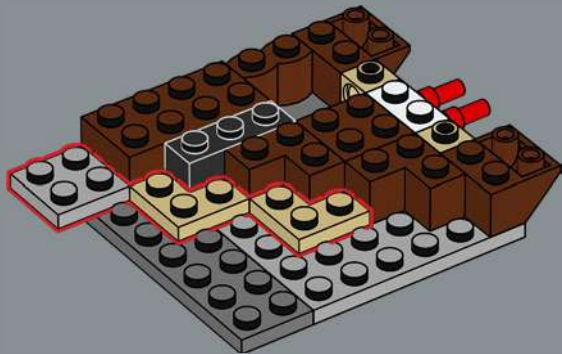


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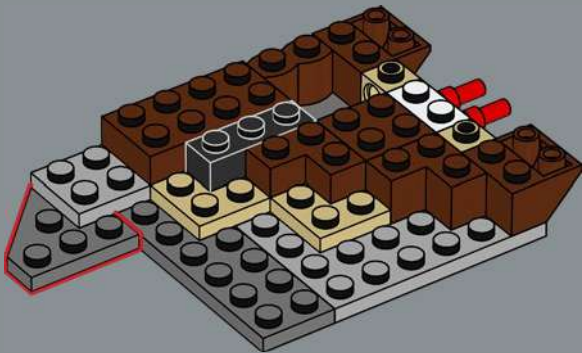




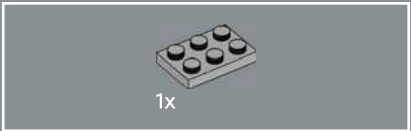
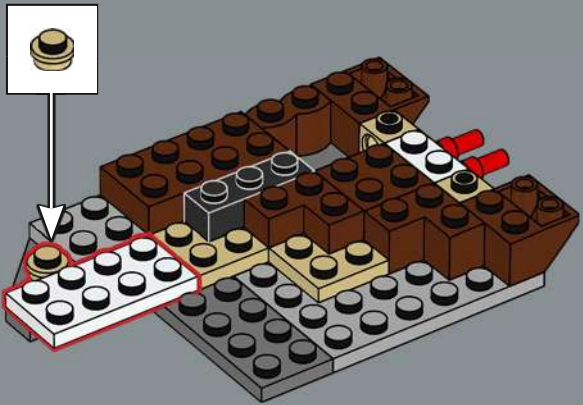
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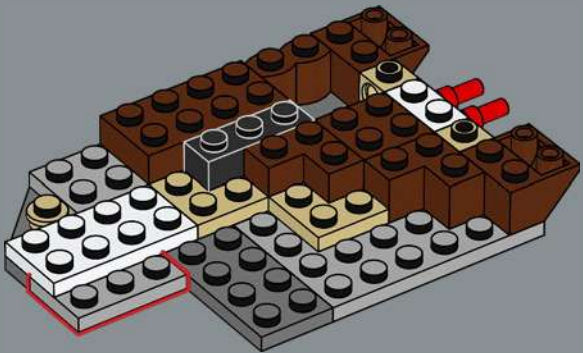
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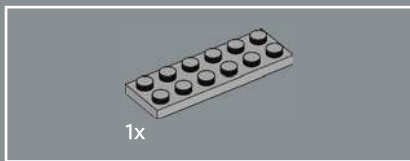


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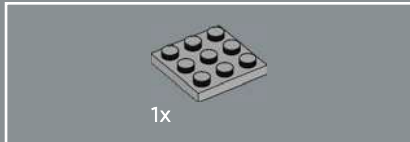
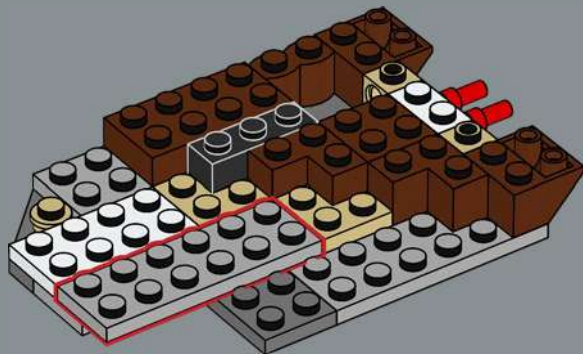


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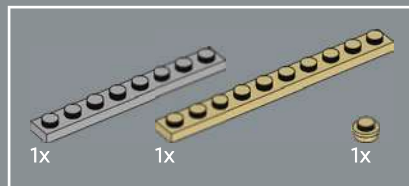
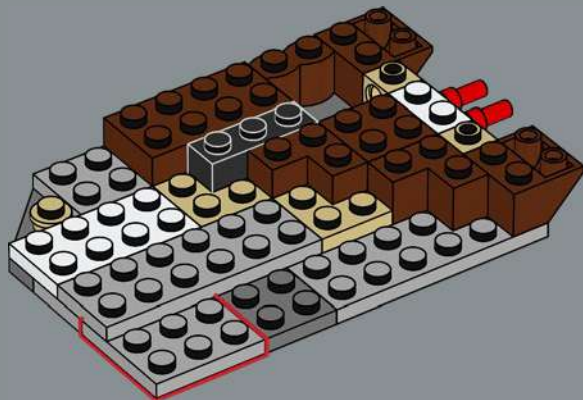




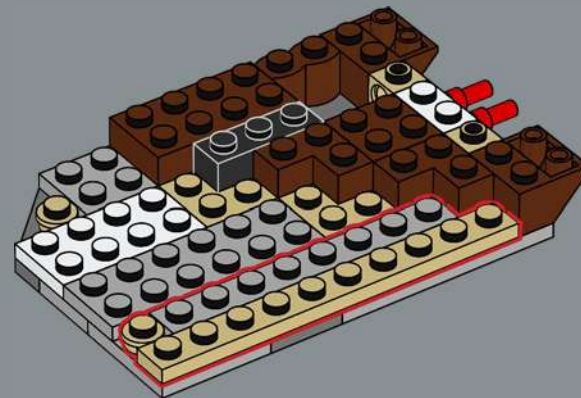
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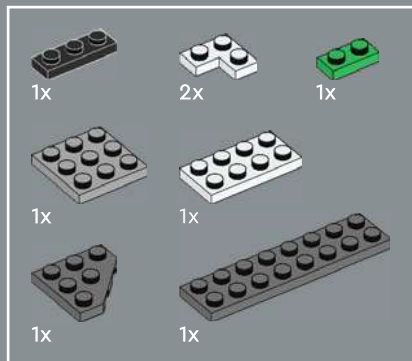


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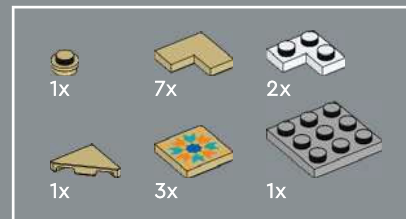
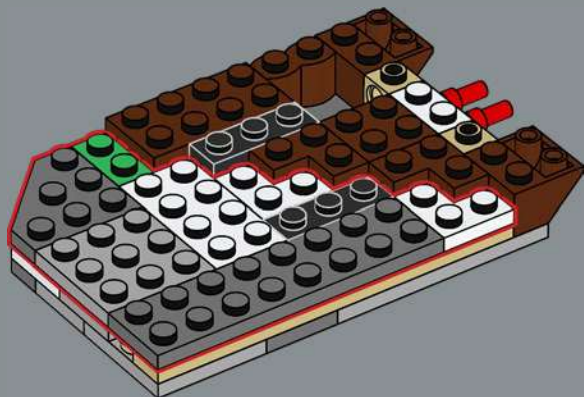


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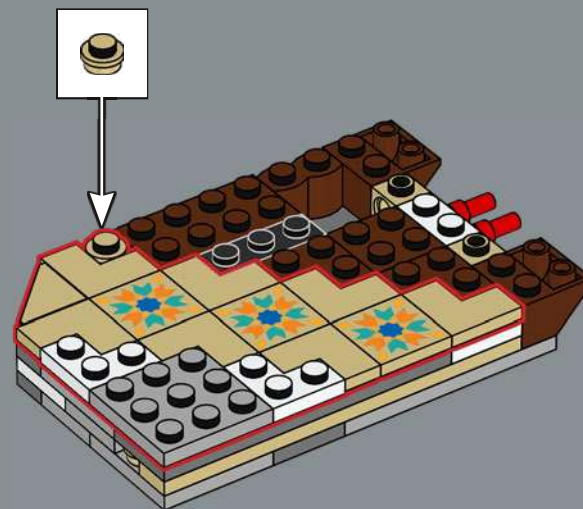


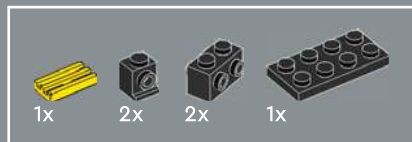


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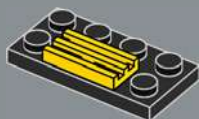
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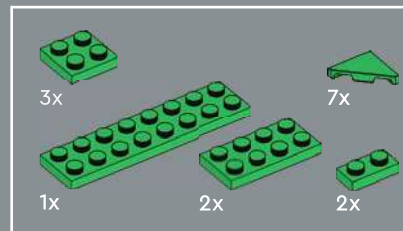
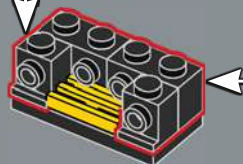
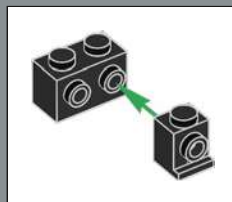
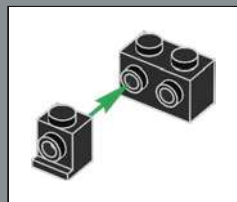


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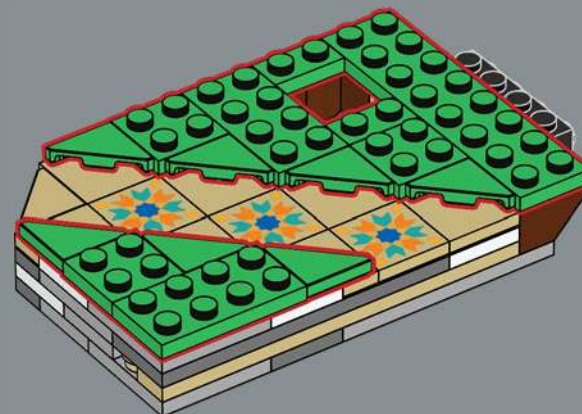
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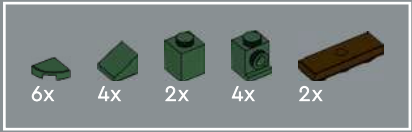
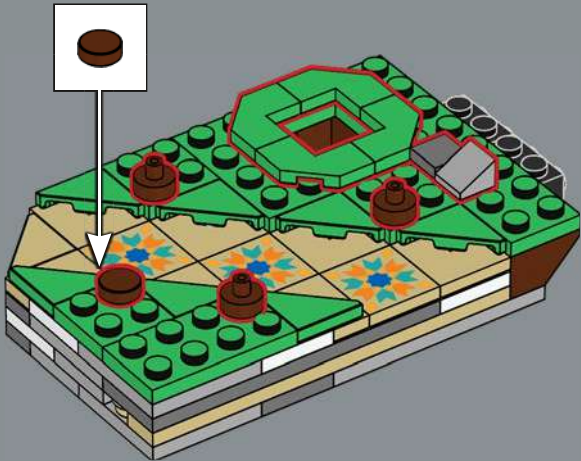


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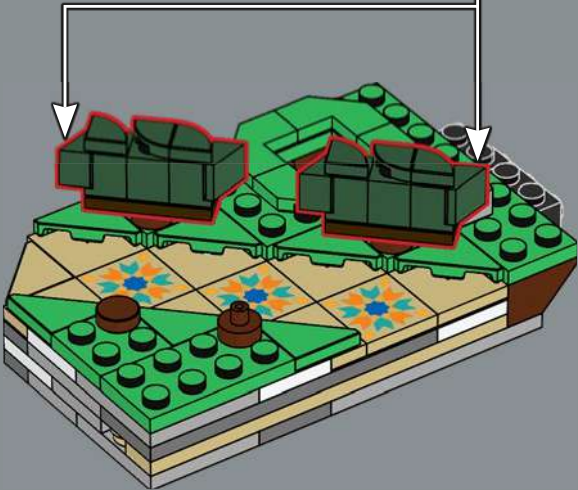
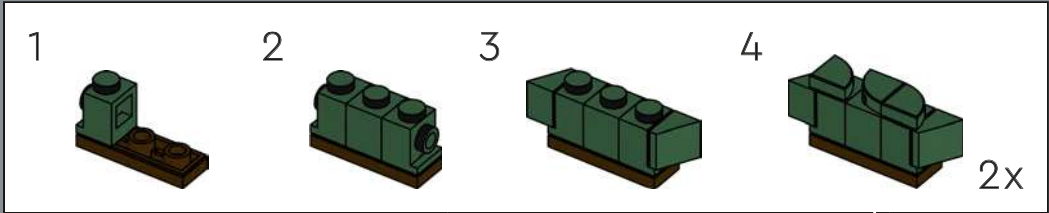


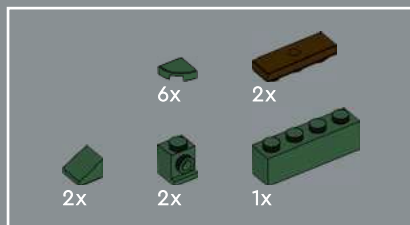


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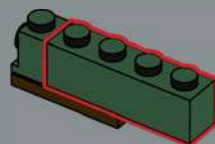


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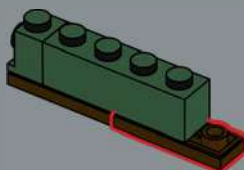
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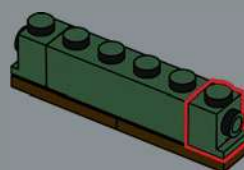
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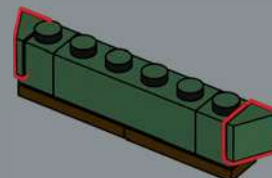
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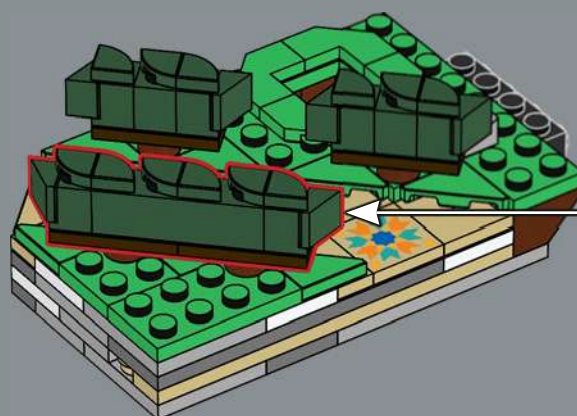
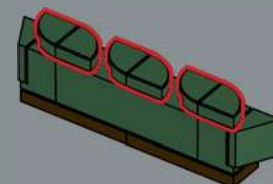
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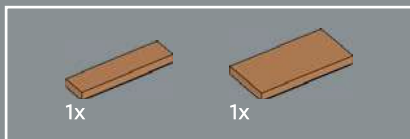


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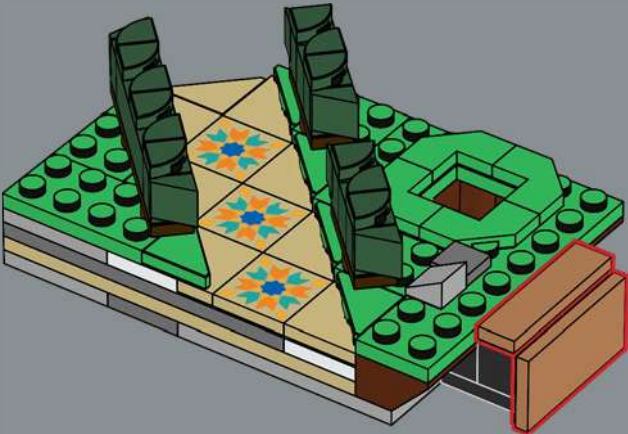


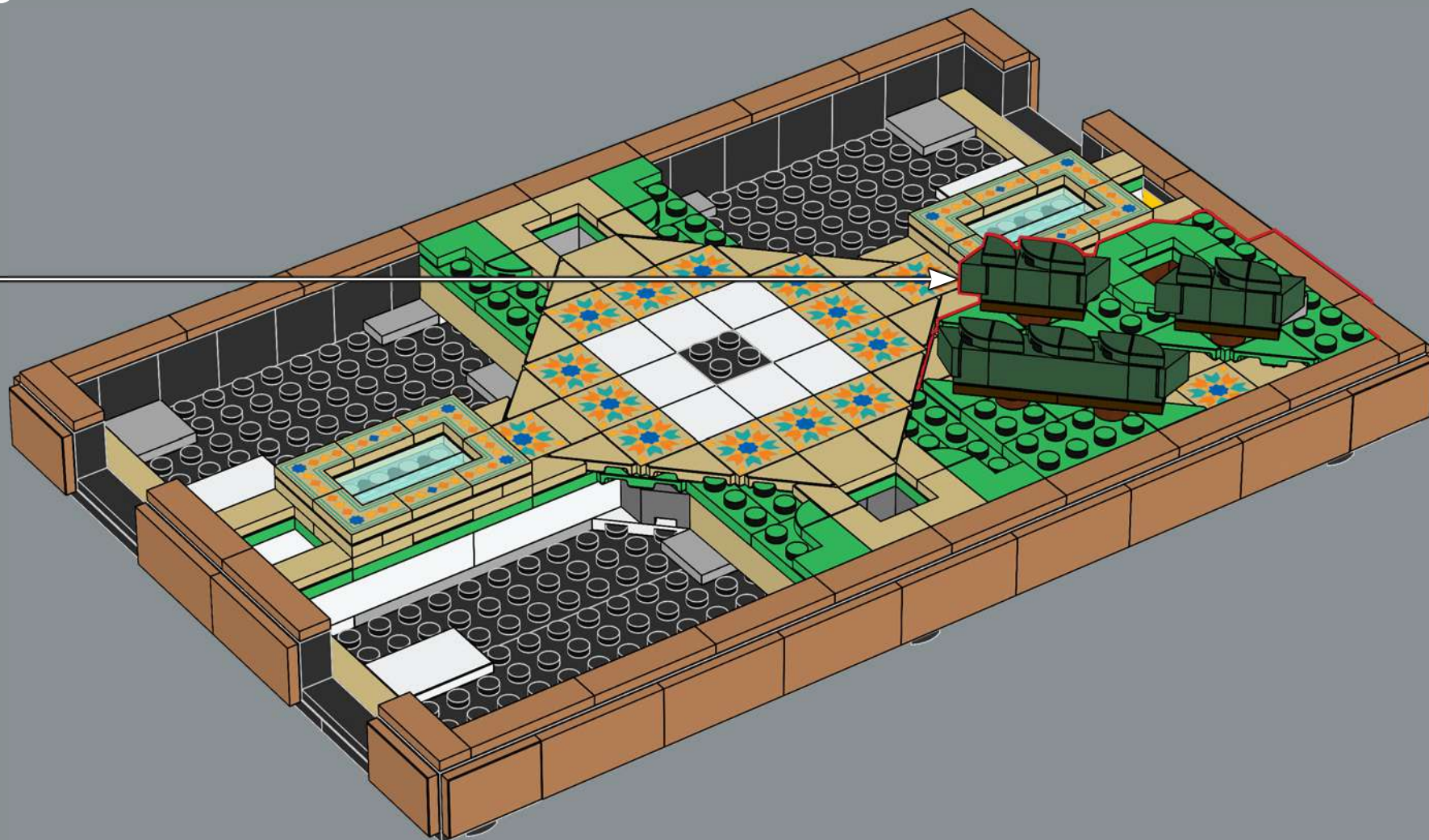
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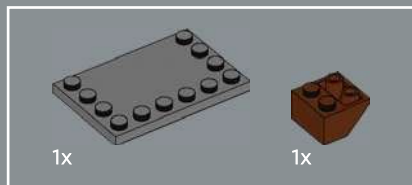
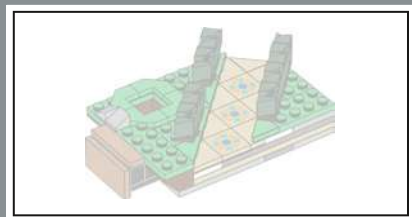




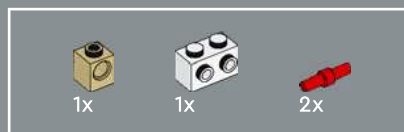
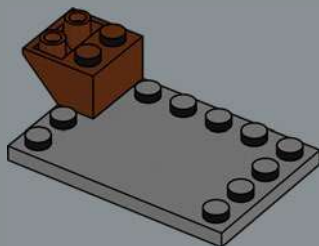
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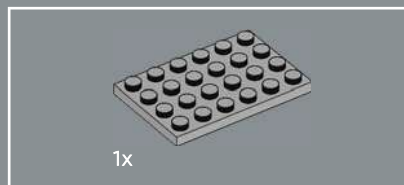
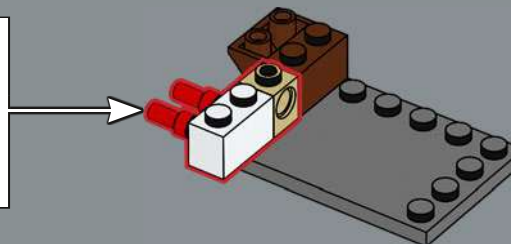
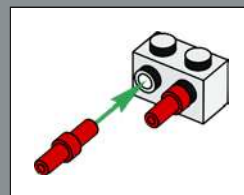




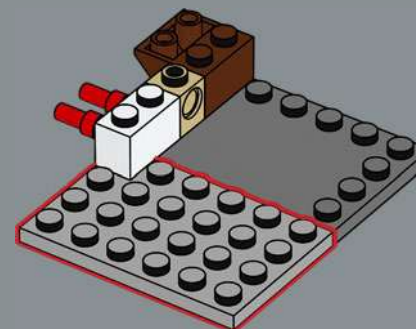
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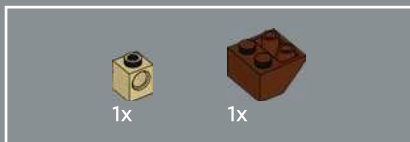


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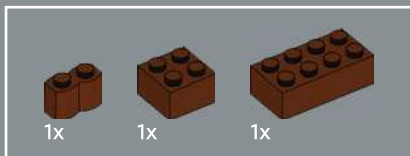
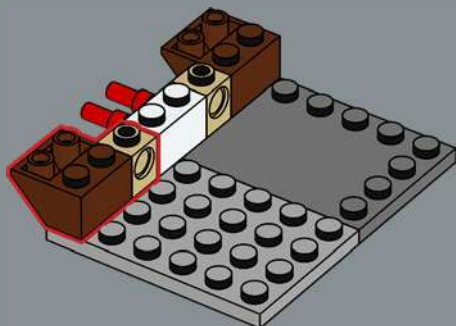


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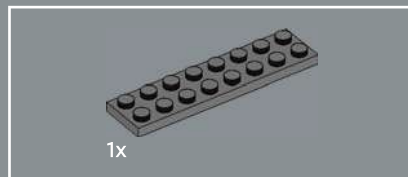
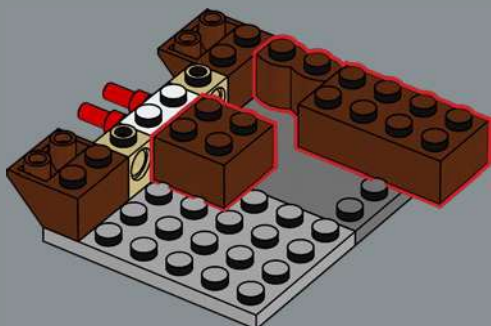




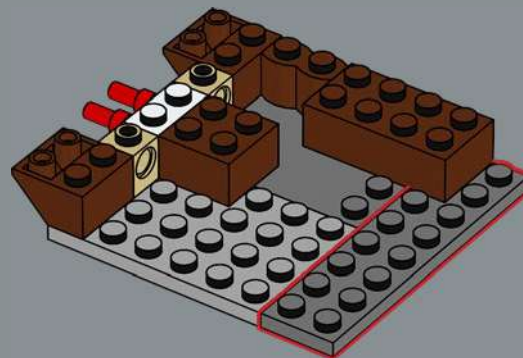
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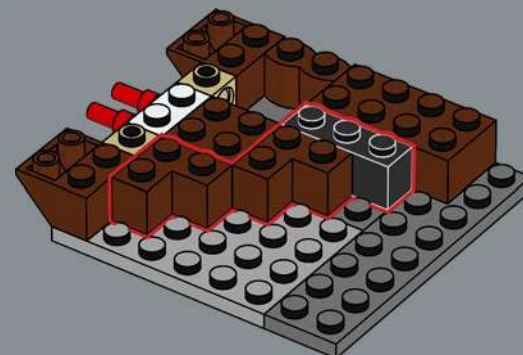
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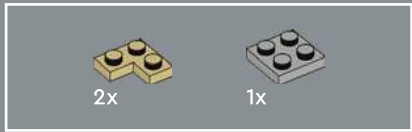


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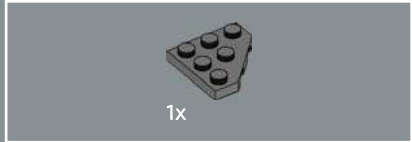
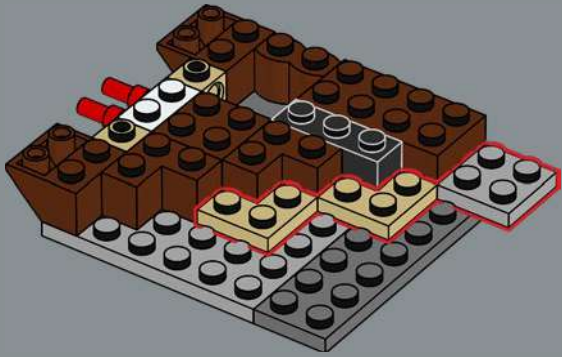


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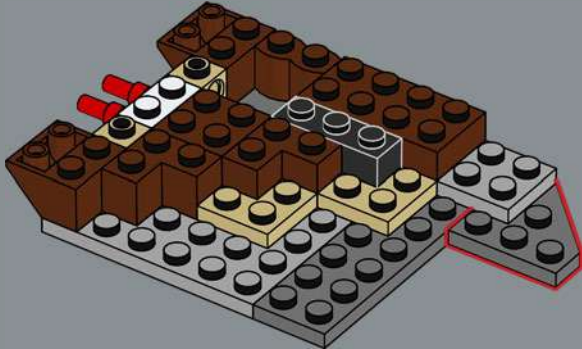




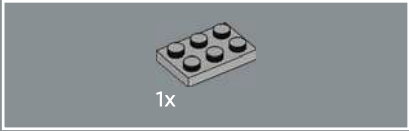
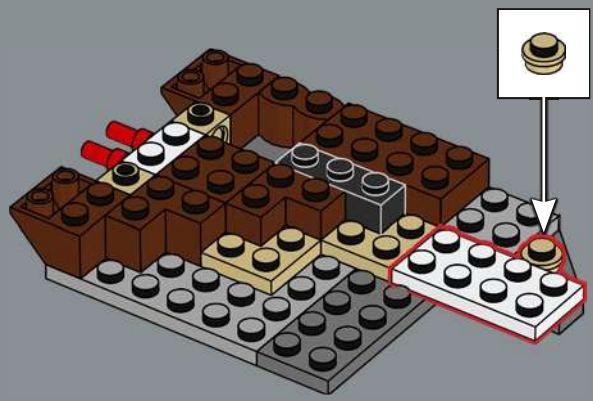
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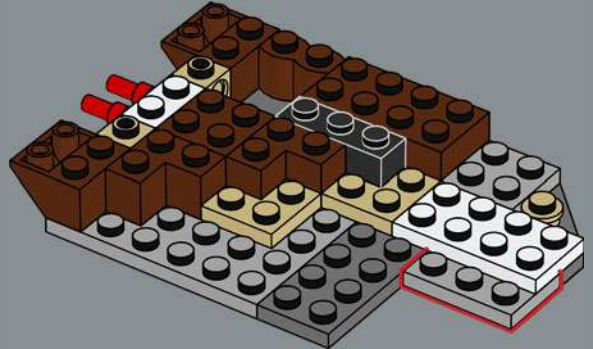
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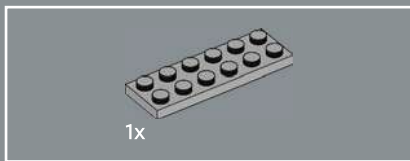


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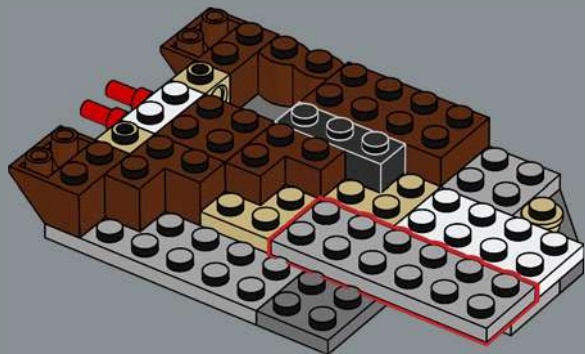


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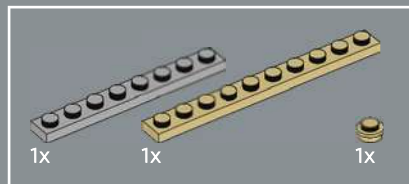
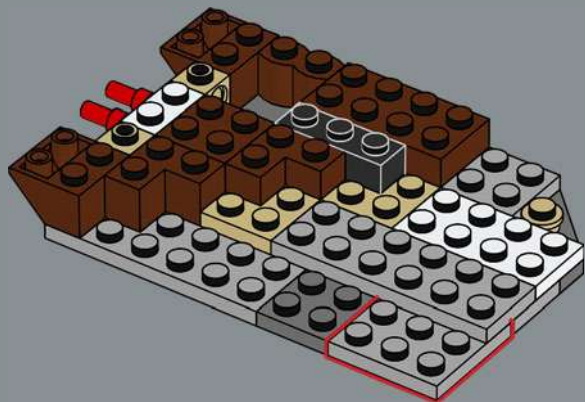




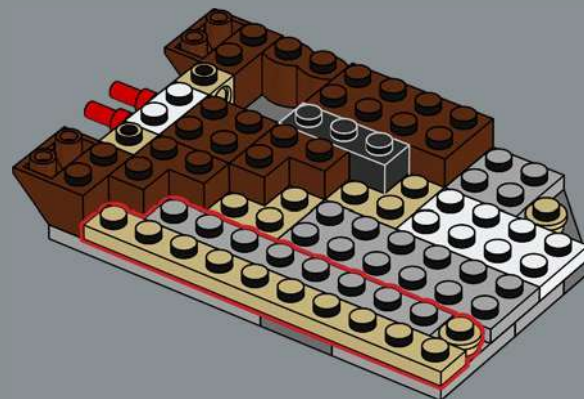
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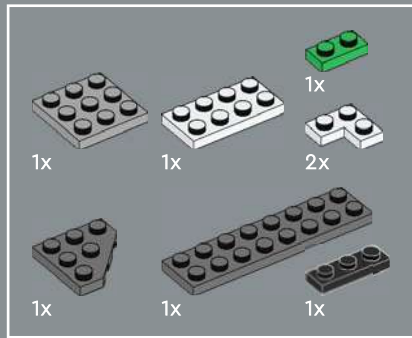


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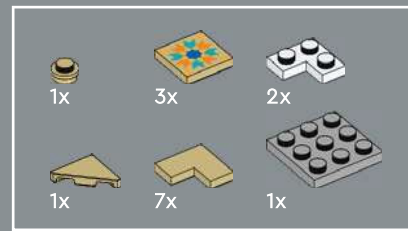
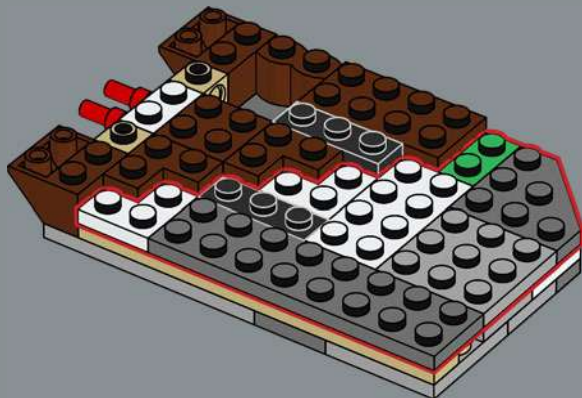


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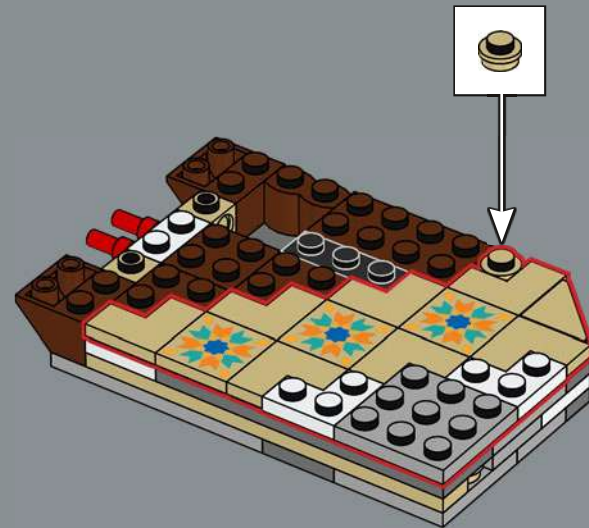


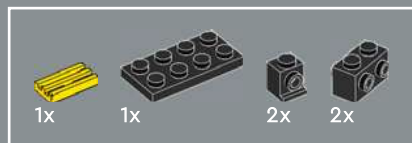


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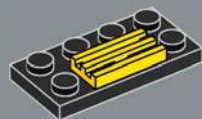
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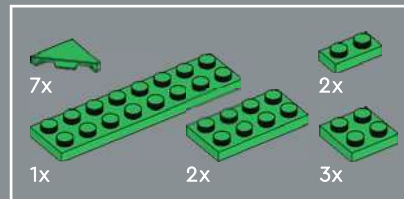
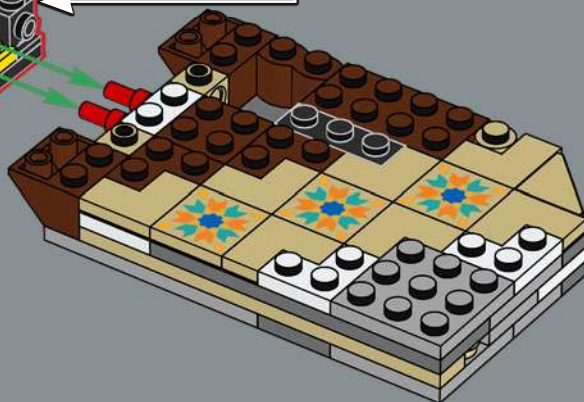
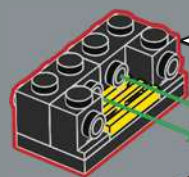
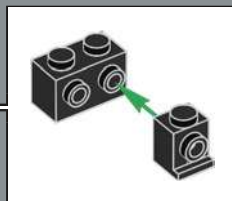
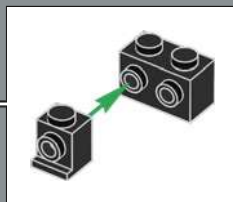
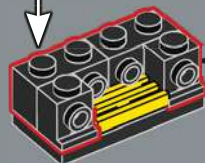


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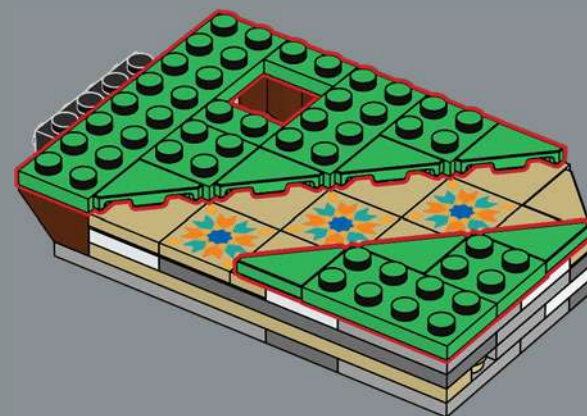
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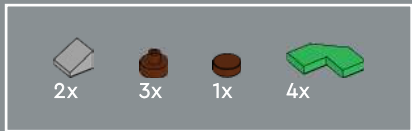


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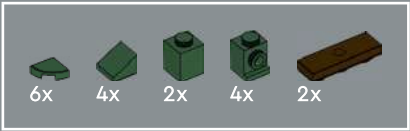
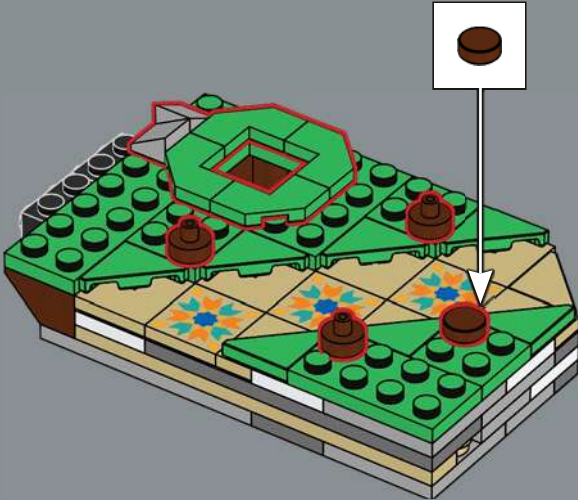


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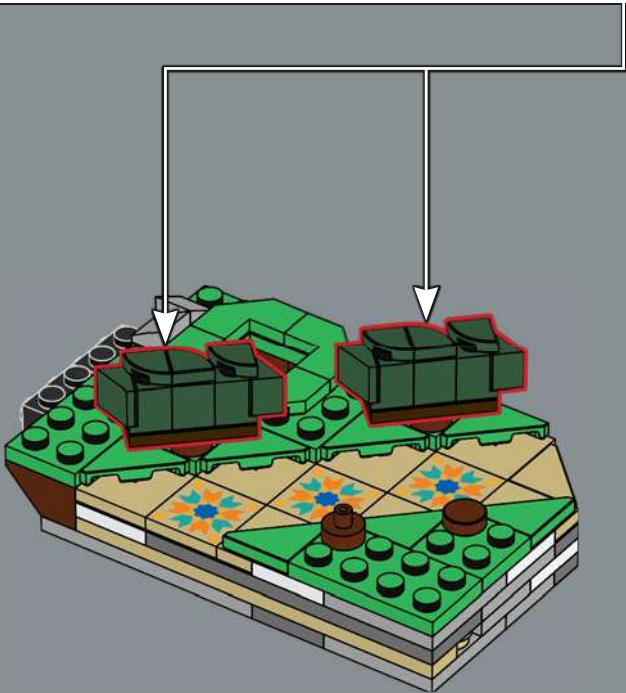
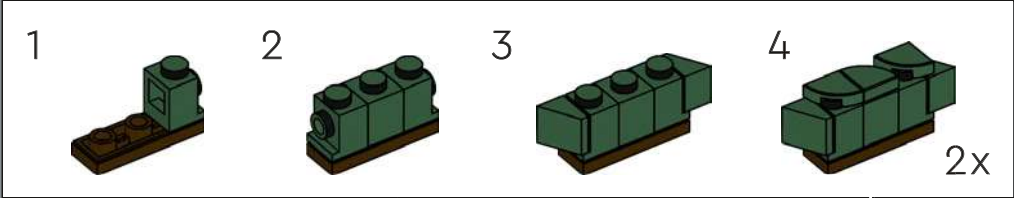


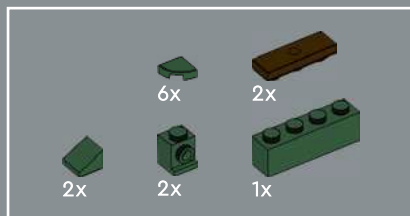


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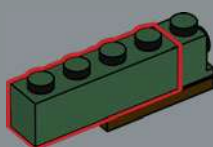


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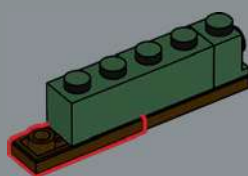
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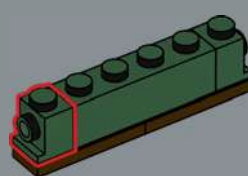
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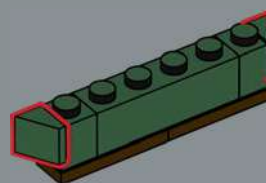
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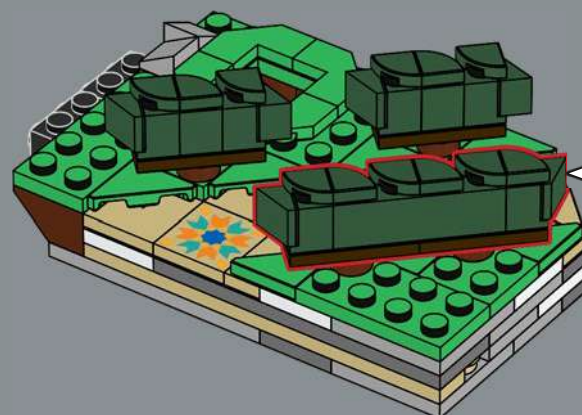
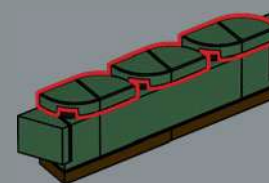
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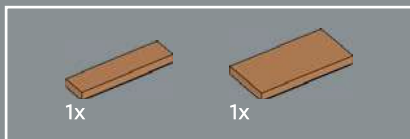


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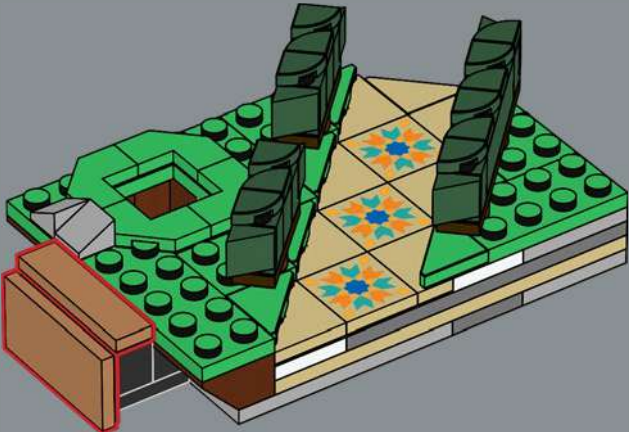


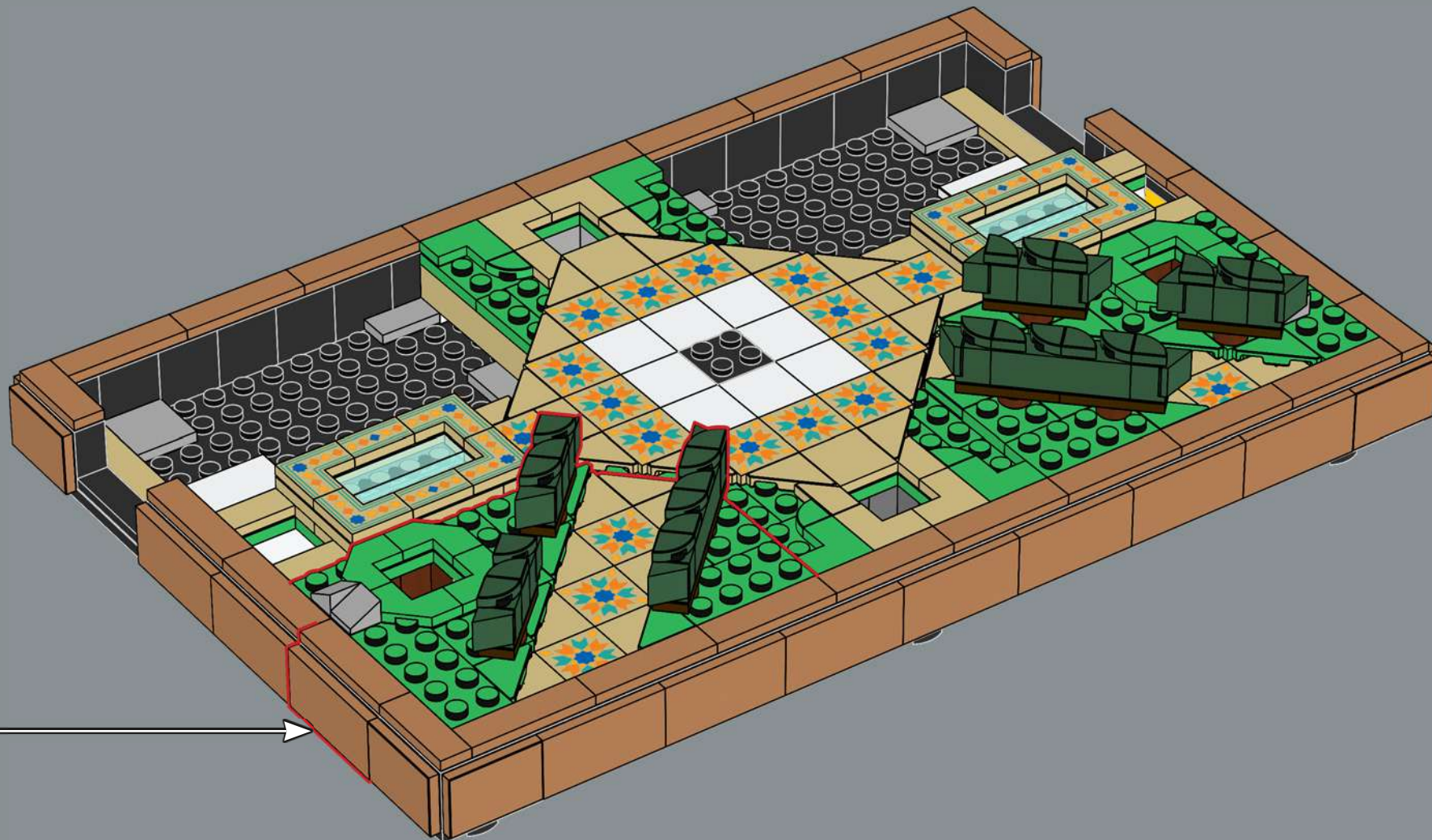
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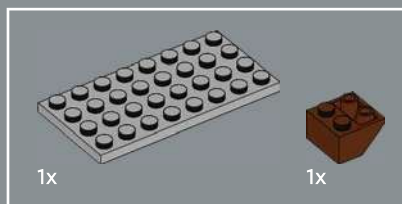
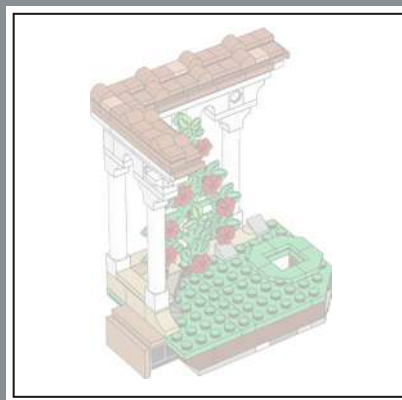




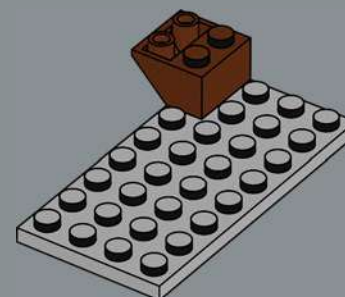
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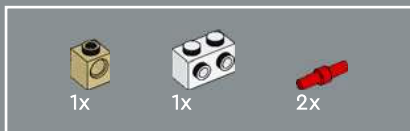




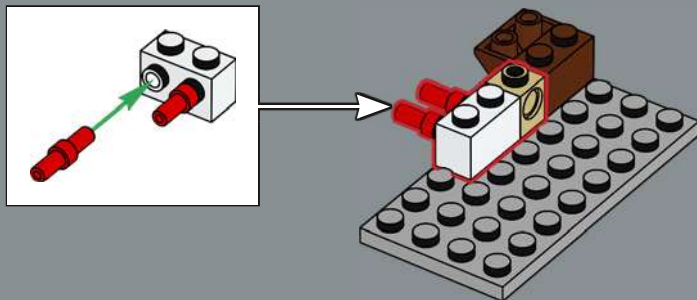


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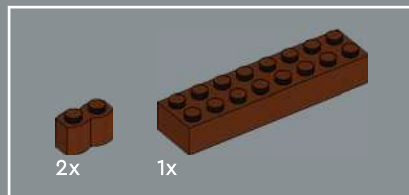
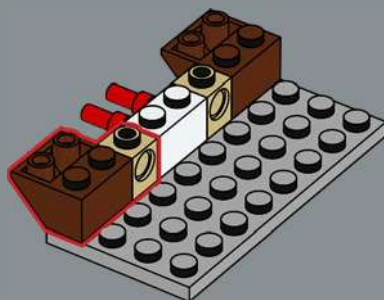




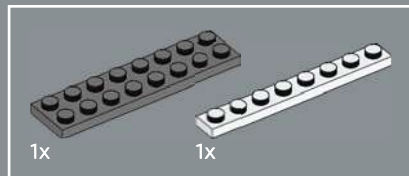
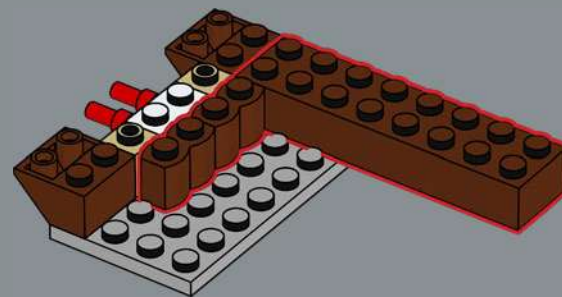
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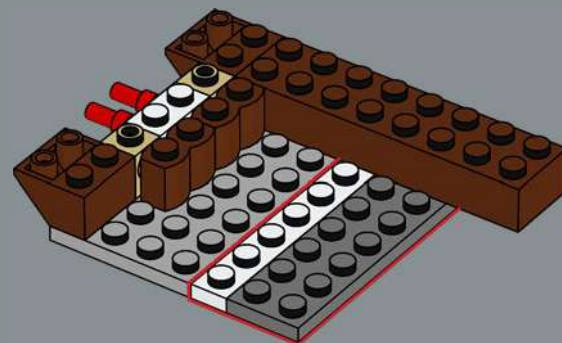
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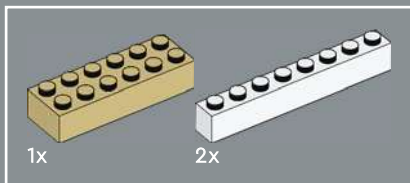


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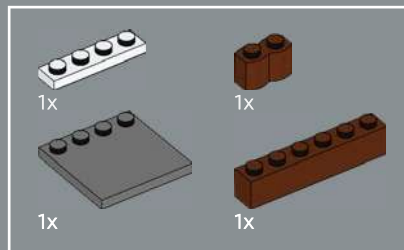
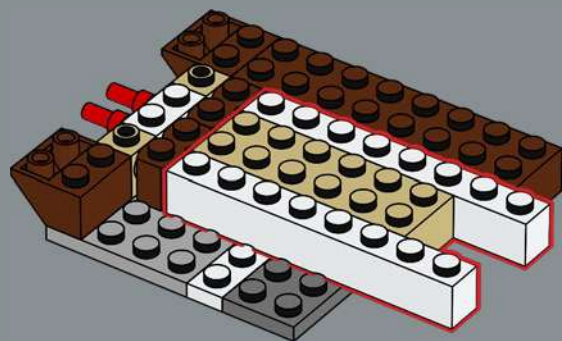


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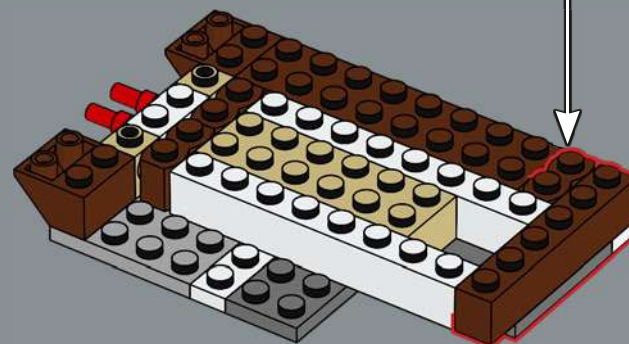
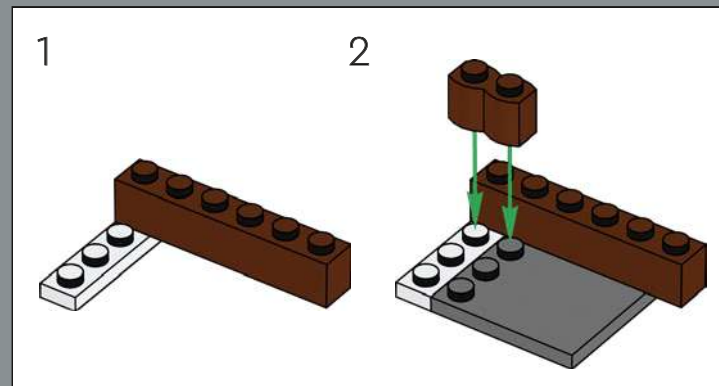


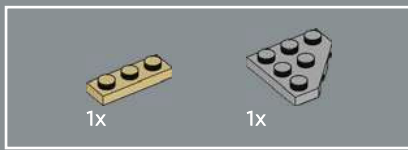


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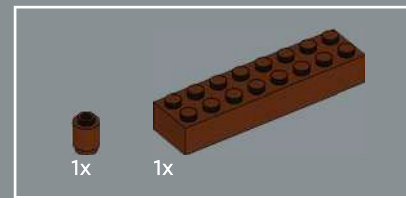
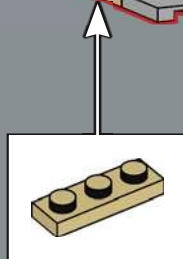
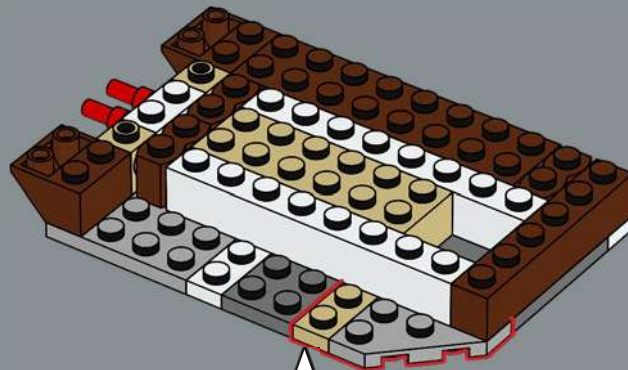


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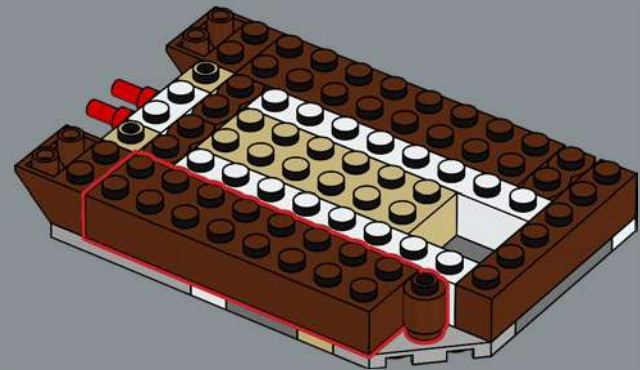


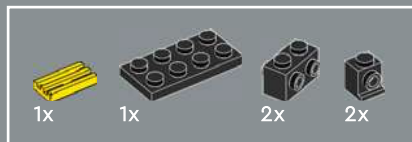


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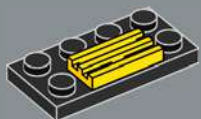
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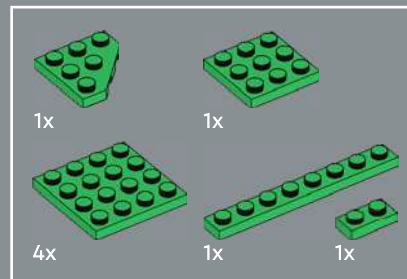
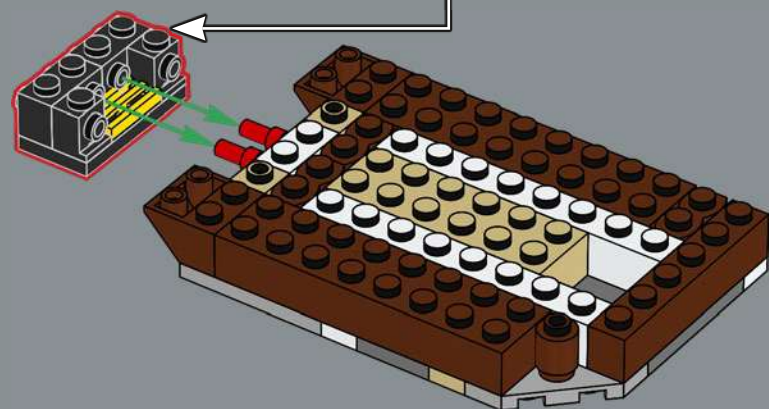
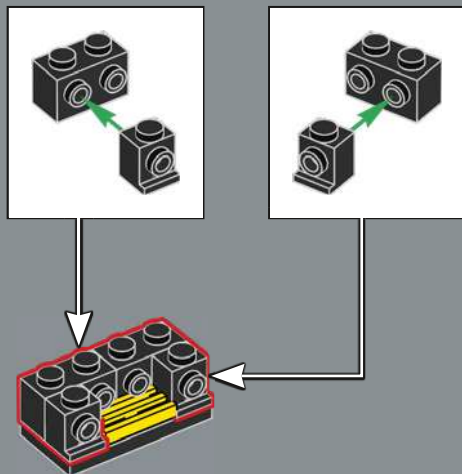


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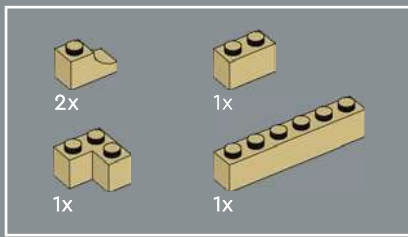


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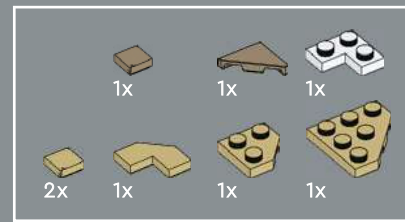
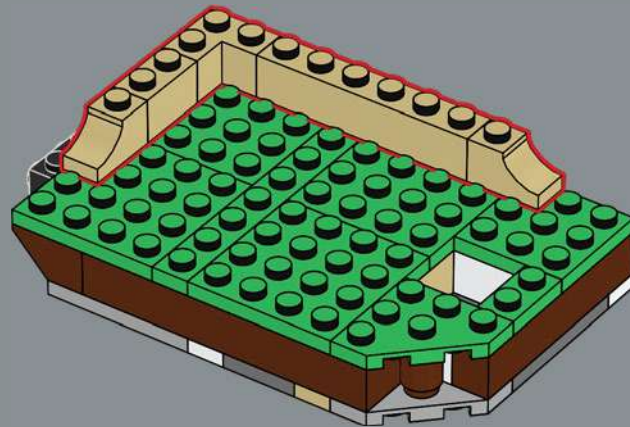


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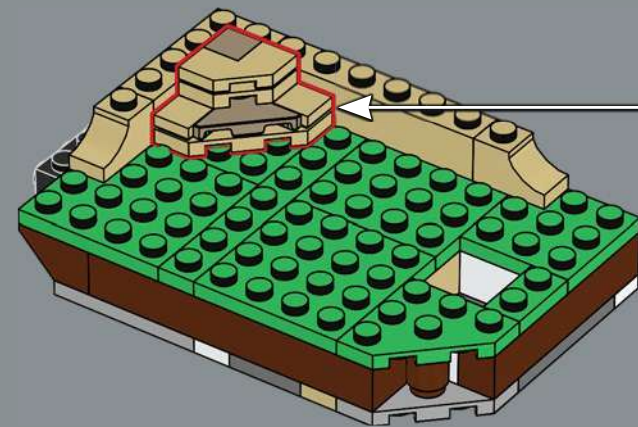
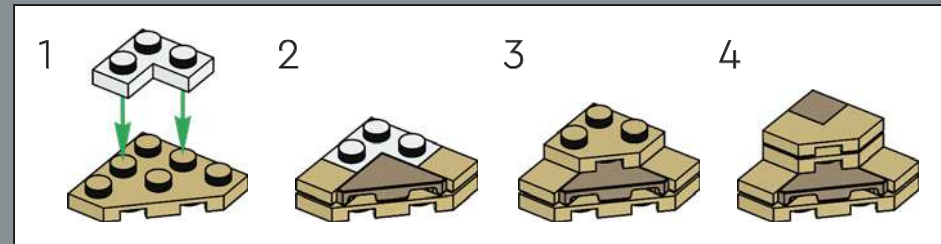




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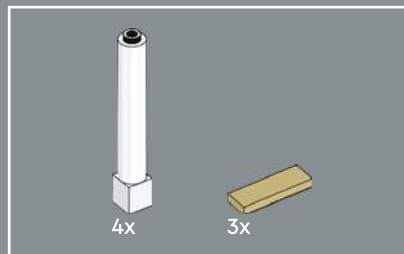
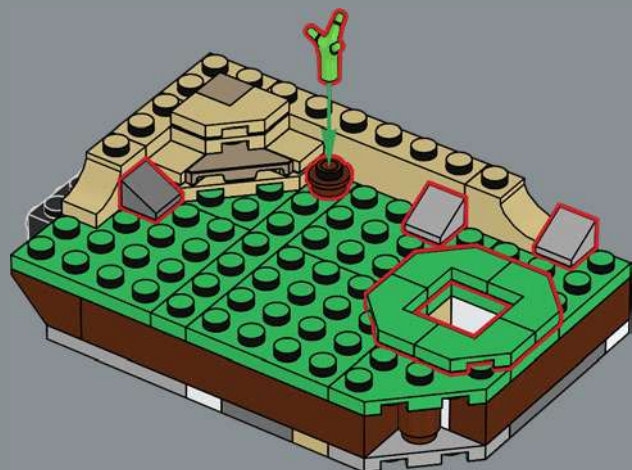


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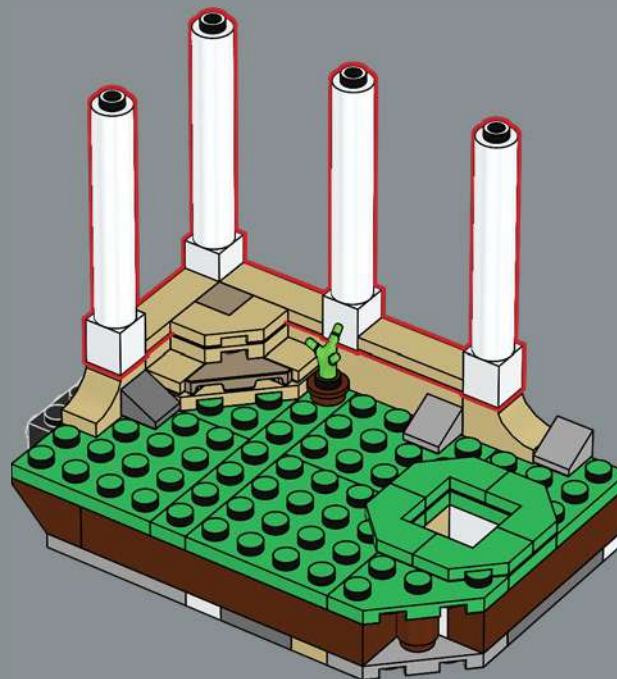


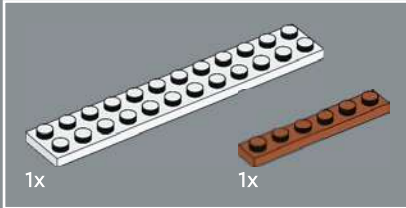
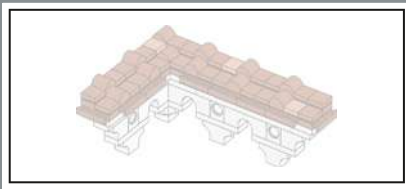


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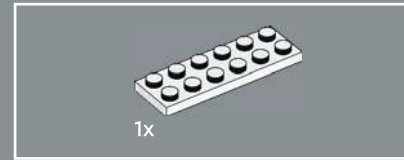
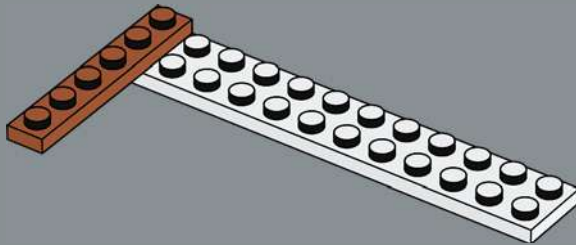


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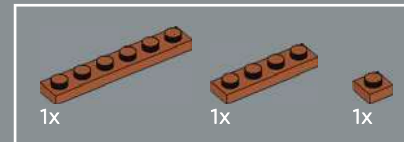
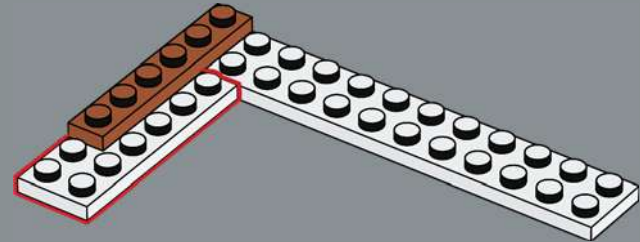




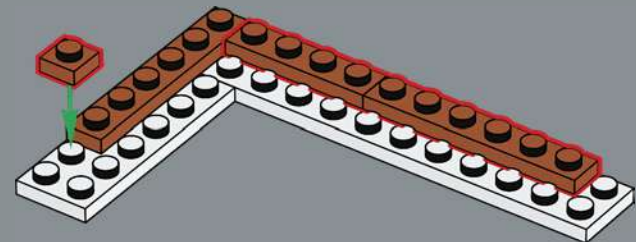
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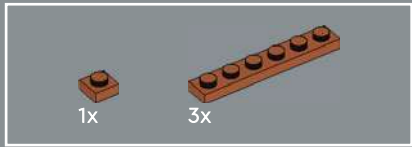
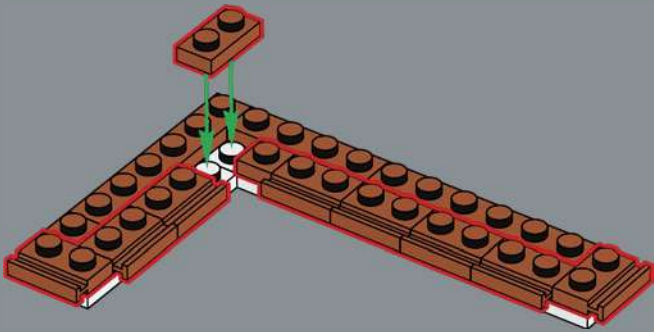


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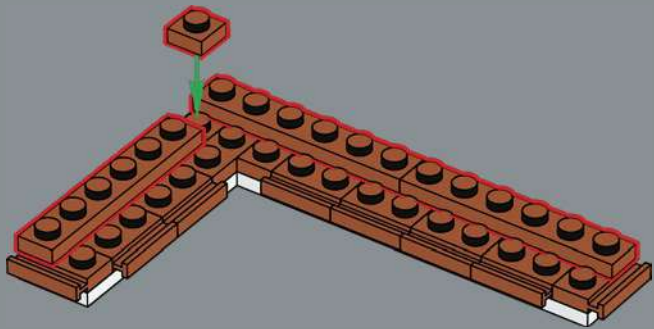




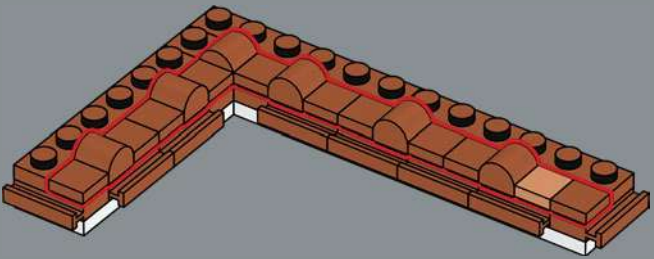
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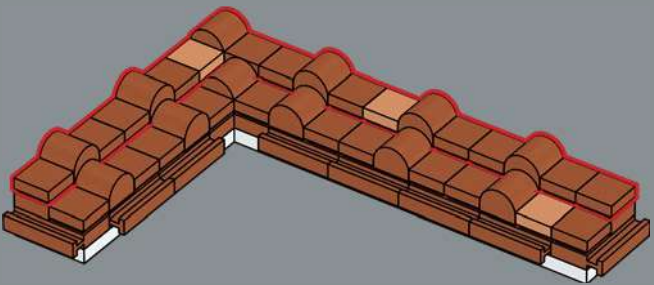
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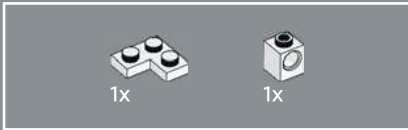
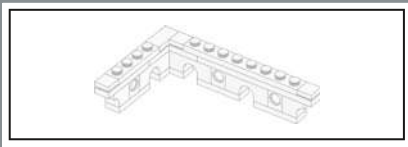


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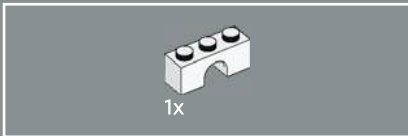
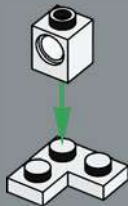


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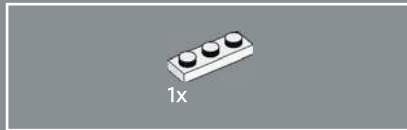




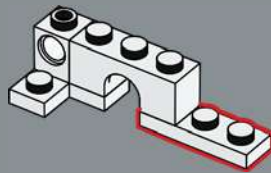
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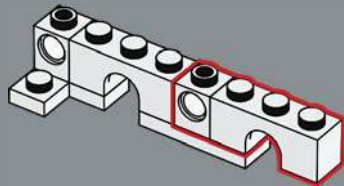
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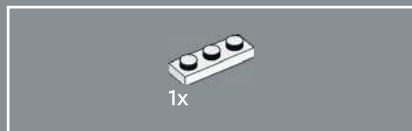


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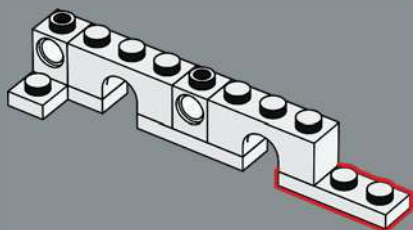


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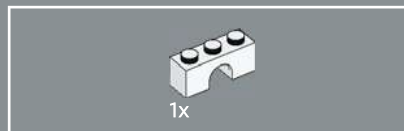
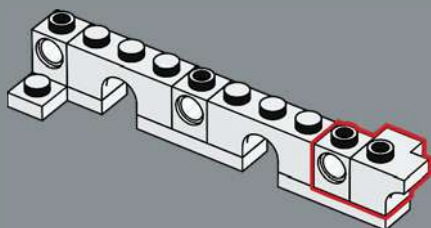




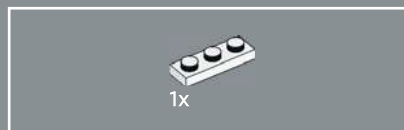
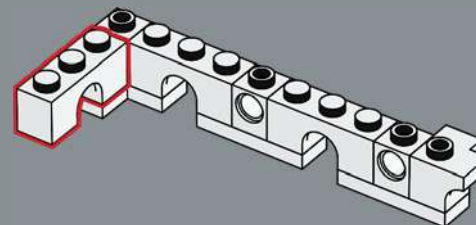
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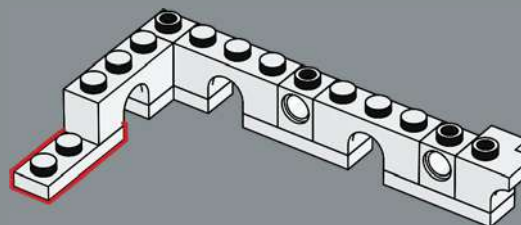
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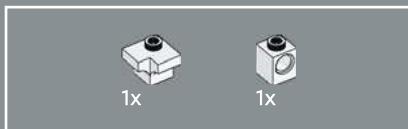


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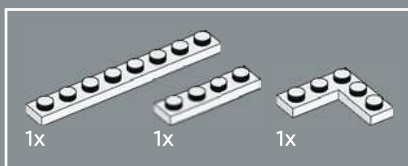
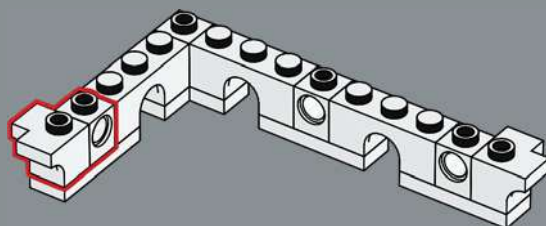


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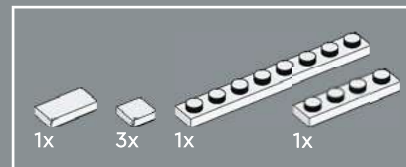
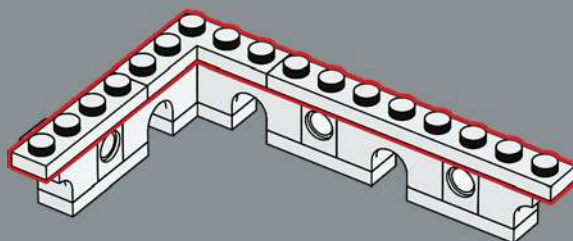




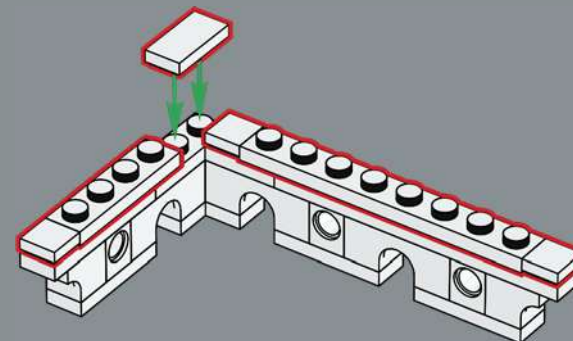
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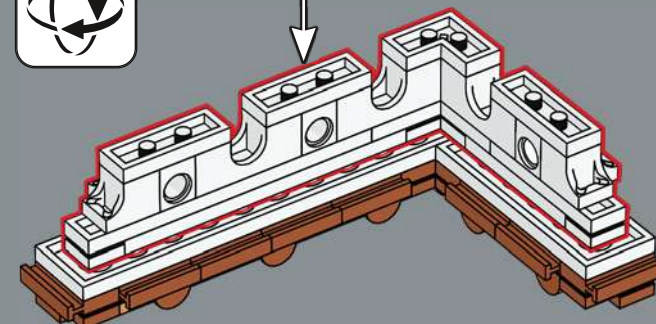
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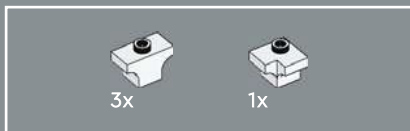


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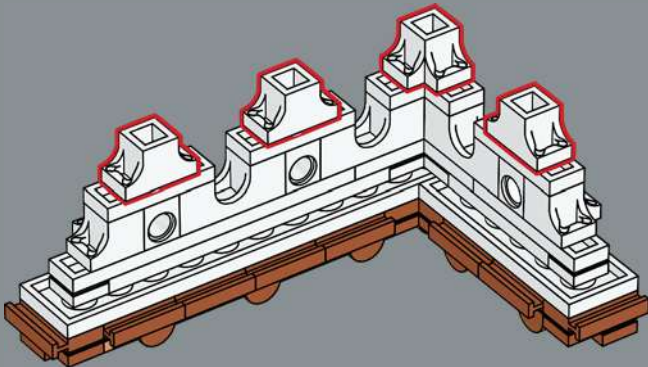


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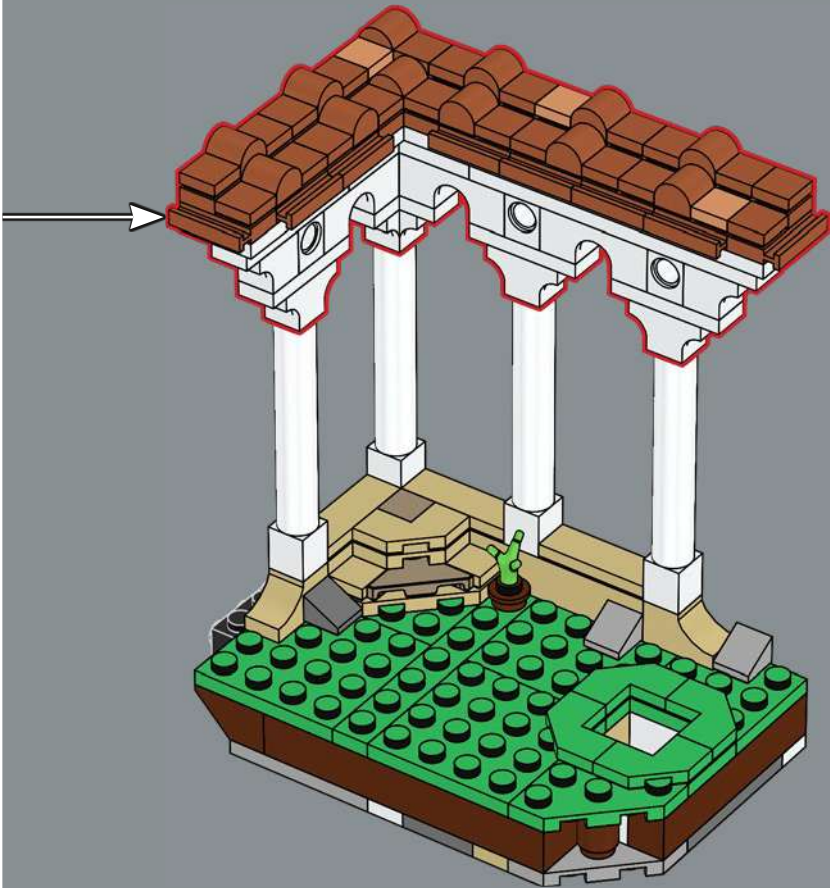


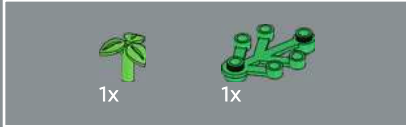
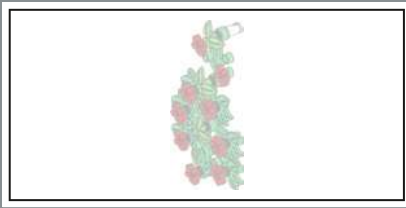


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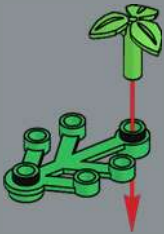


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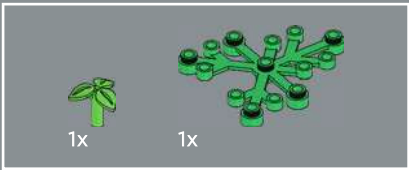




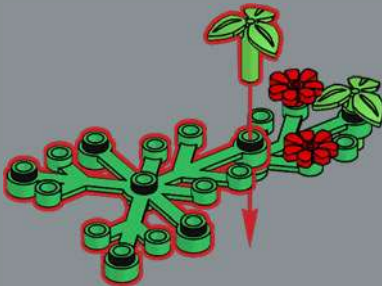
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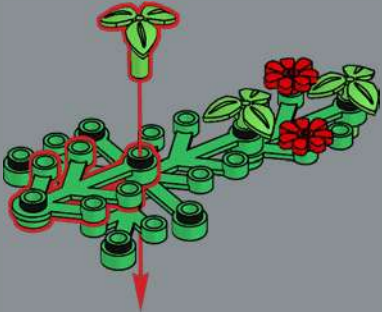

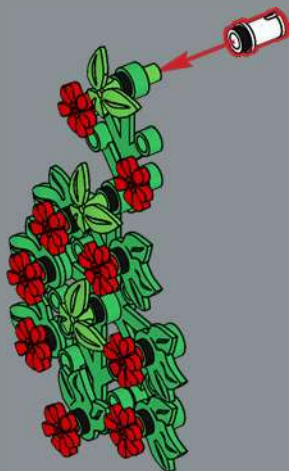
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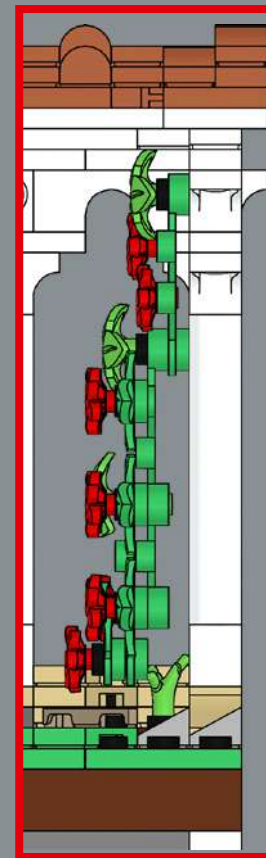
Red hibiscus flower (*Hibiscus rosa-sinensis*)

Perfect for checking the acidity of your fountain!

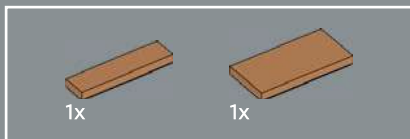

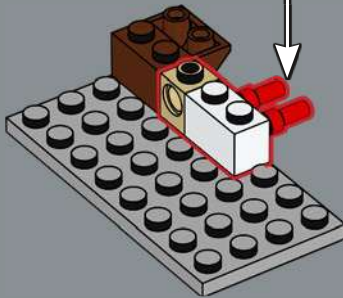
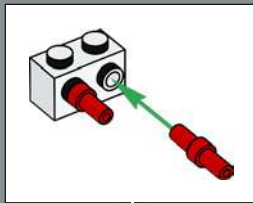


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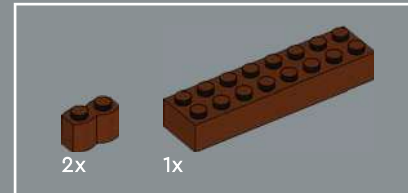
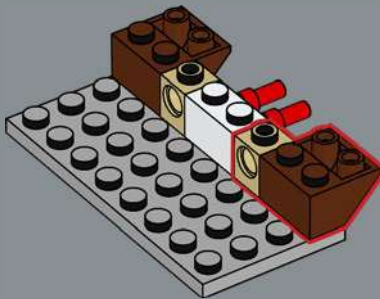




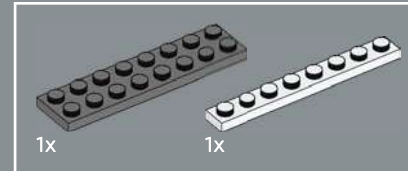
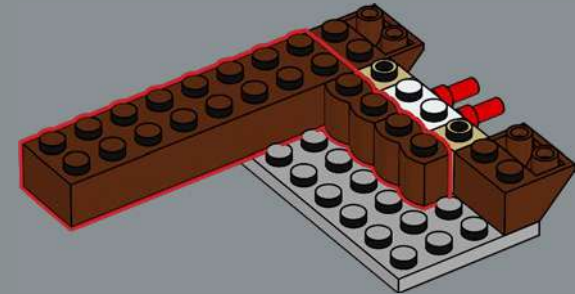
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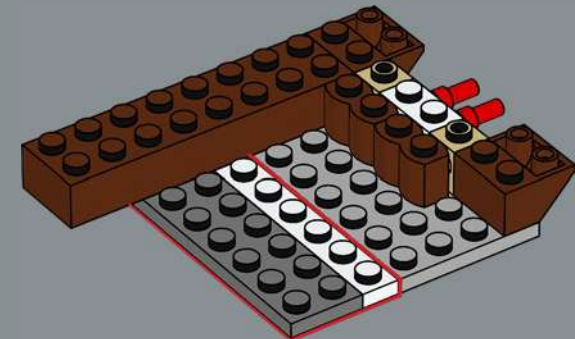
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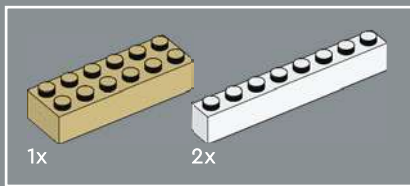


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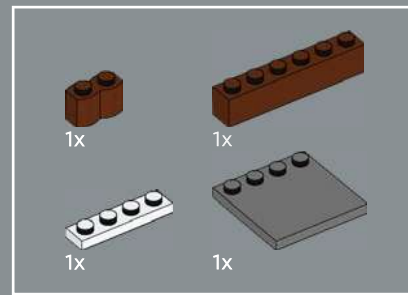
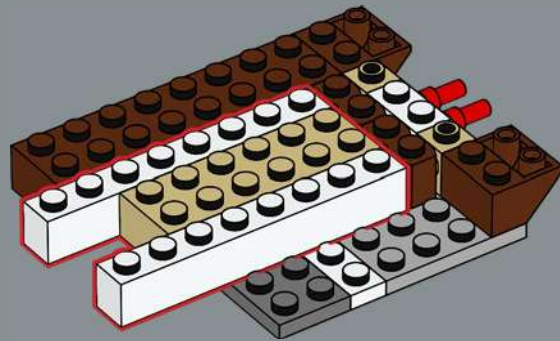


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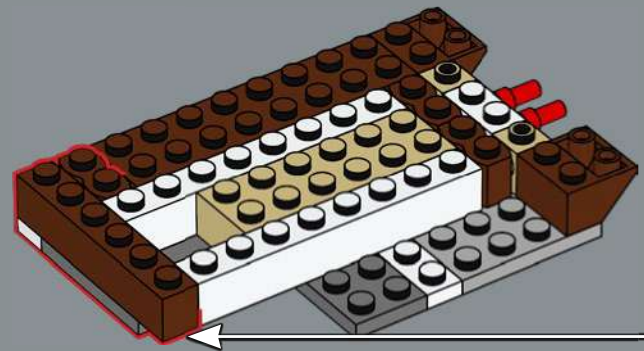
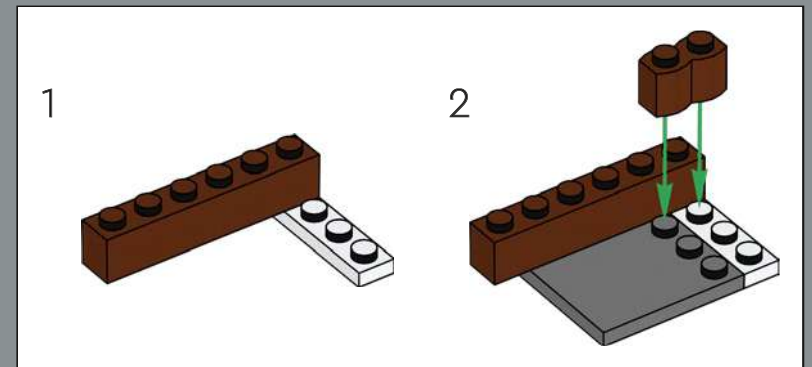


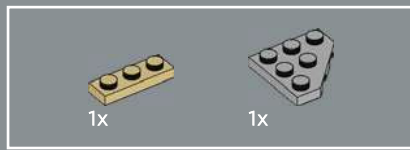


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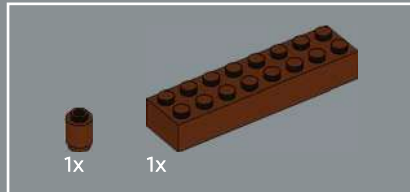
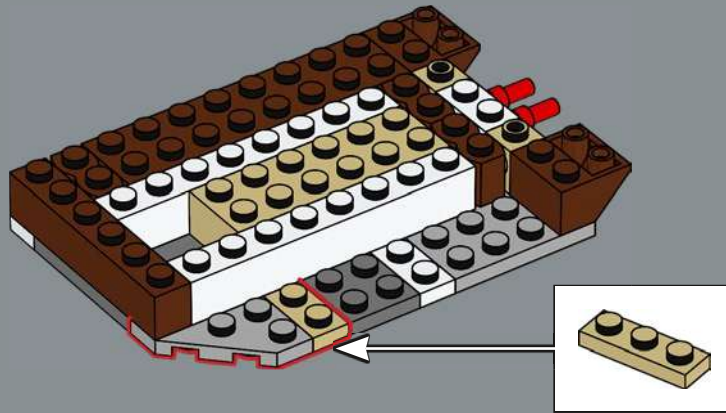


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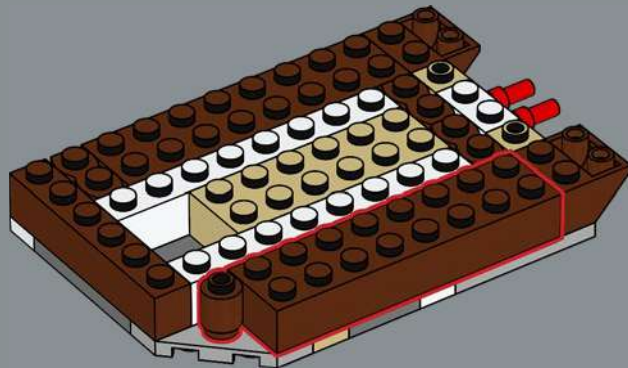




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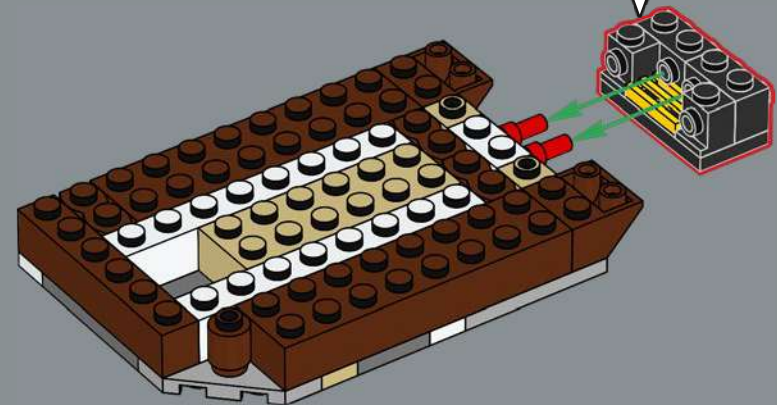
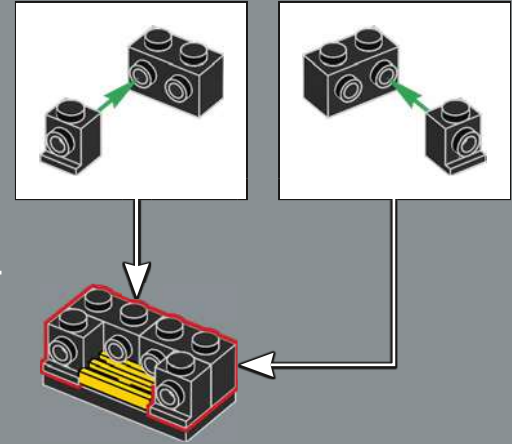


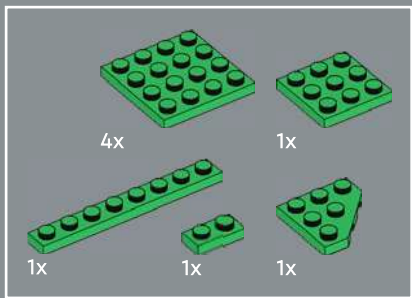
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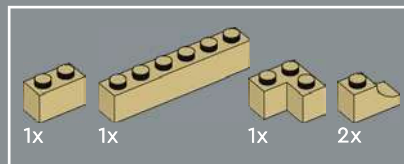


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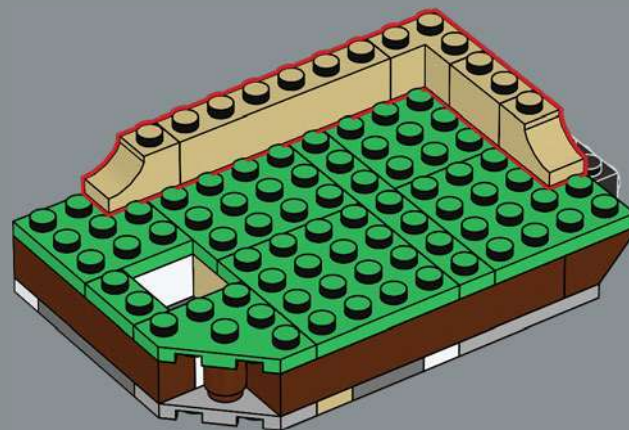


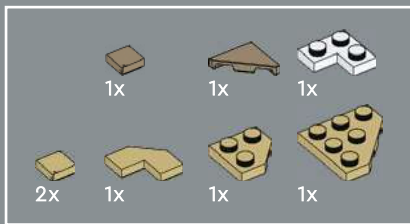


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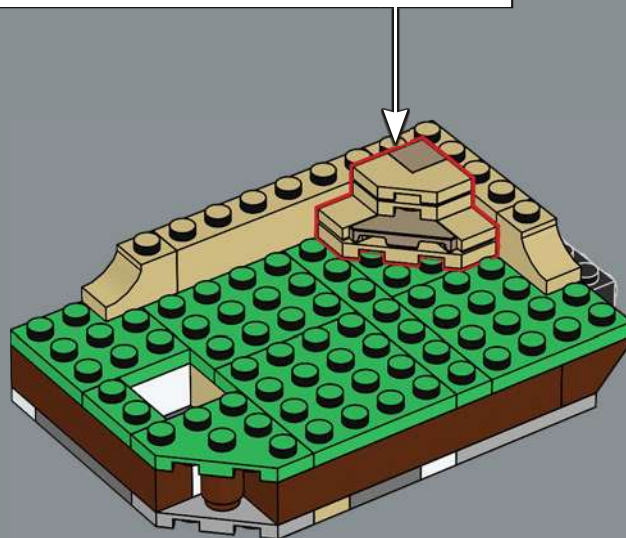
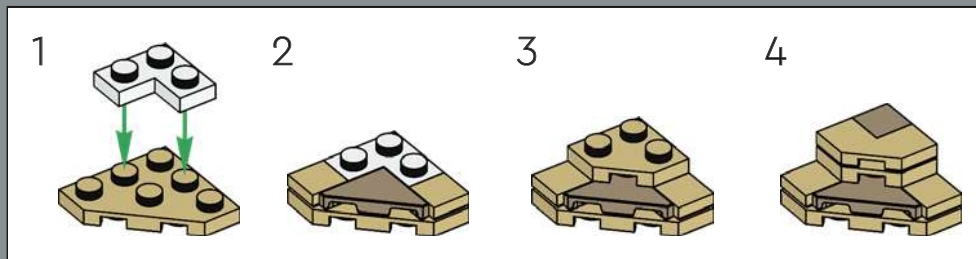


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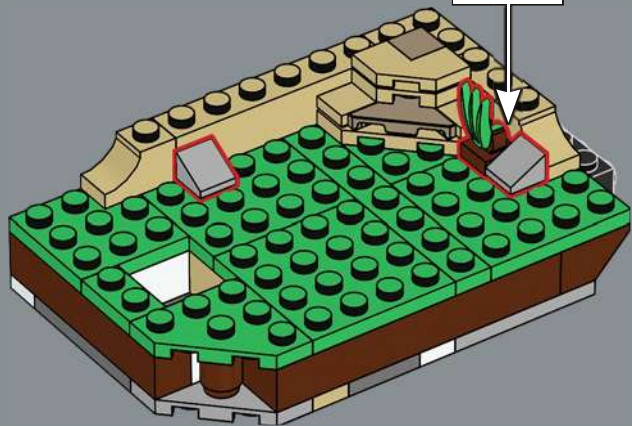


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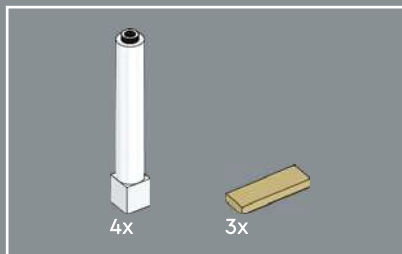
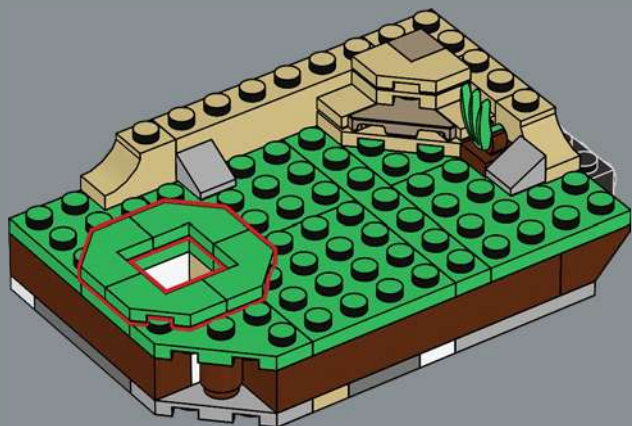




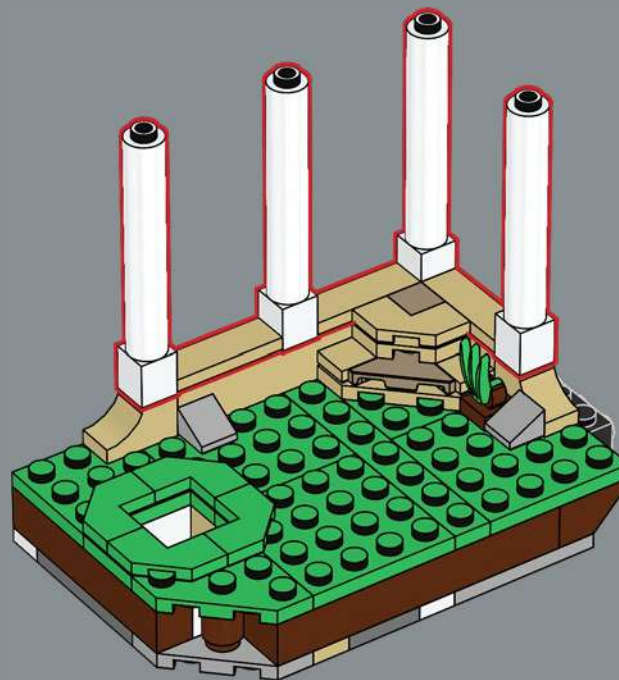
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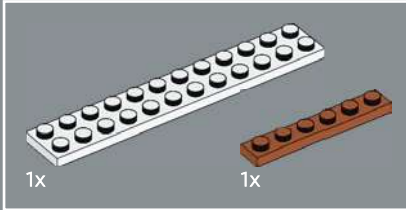
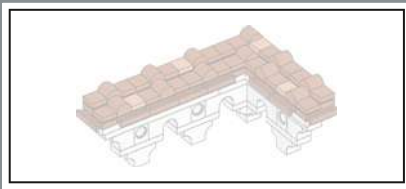


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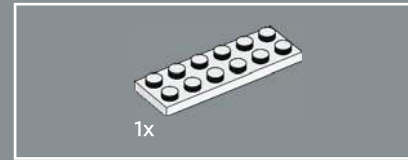
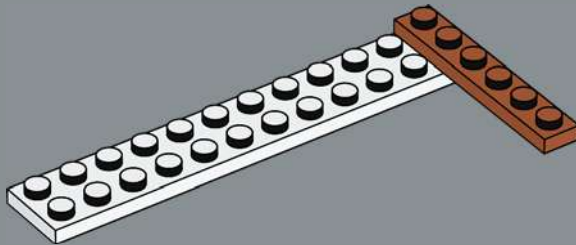


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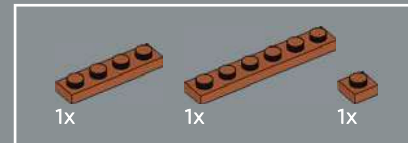
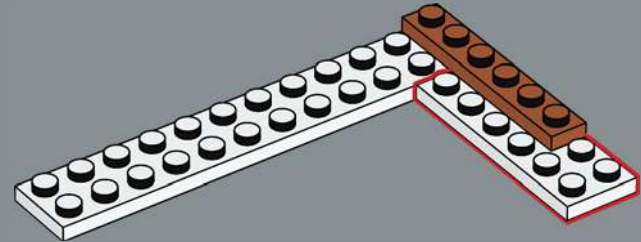




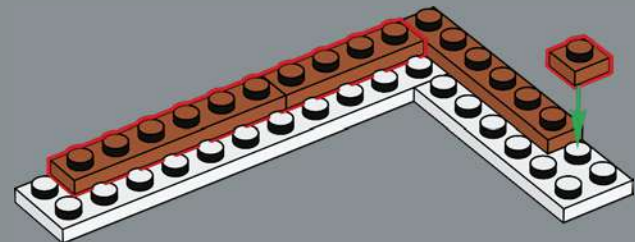
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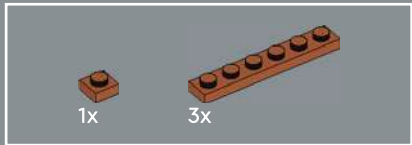
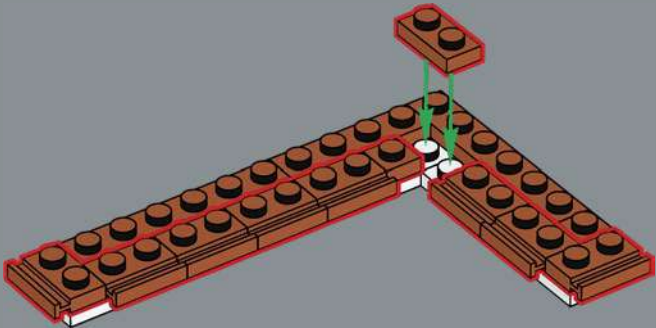


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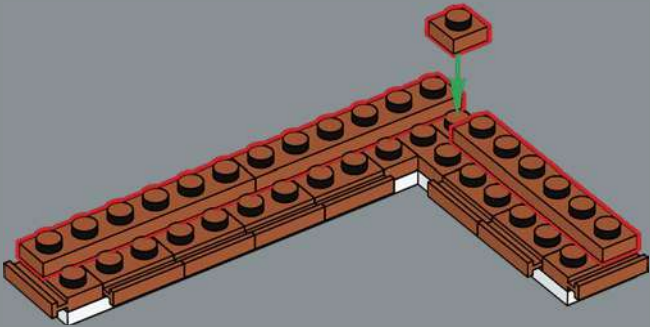




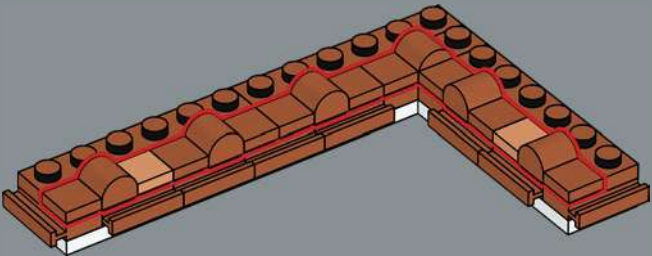
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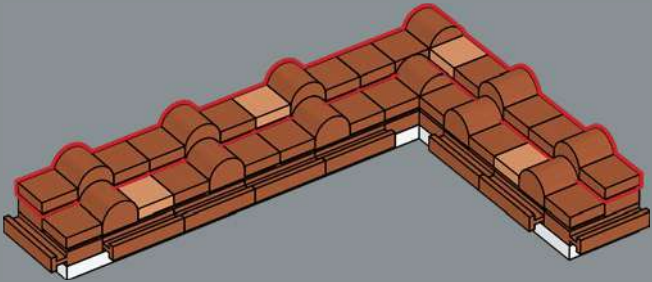
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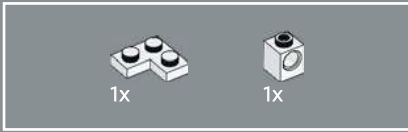
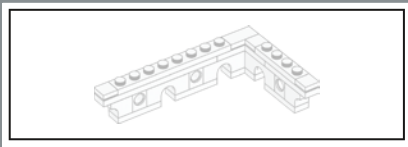


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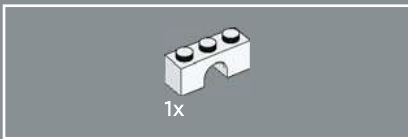
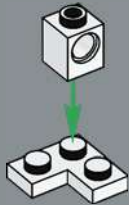


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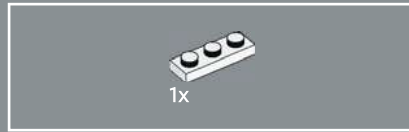




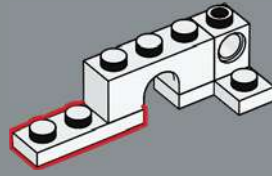
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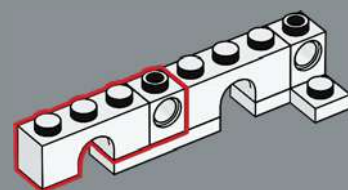
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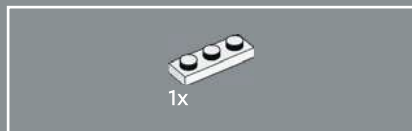


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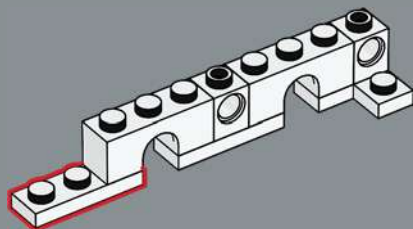


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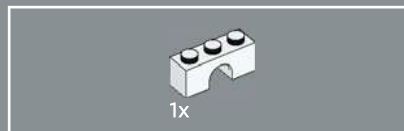
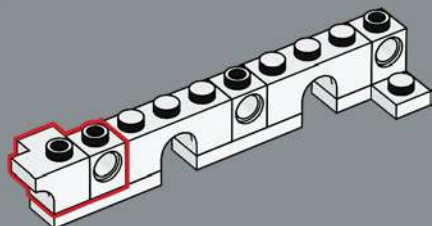




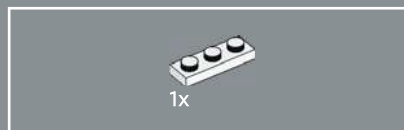
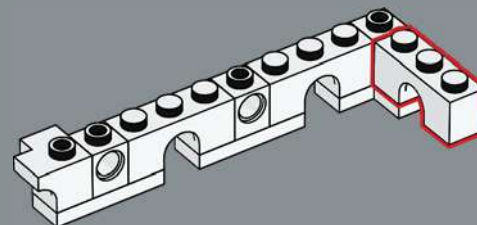
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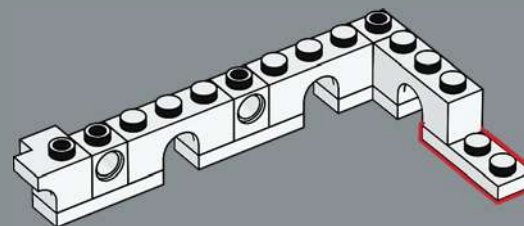
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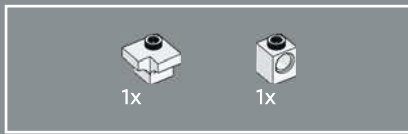


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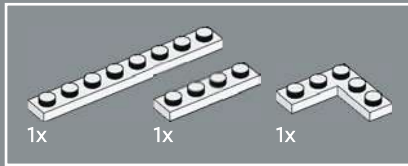
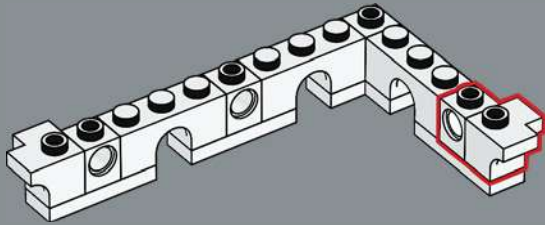


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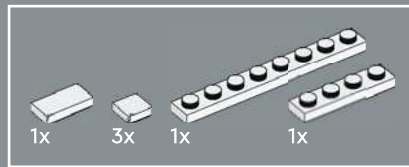
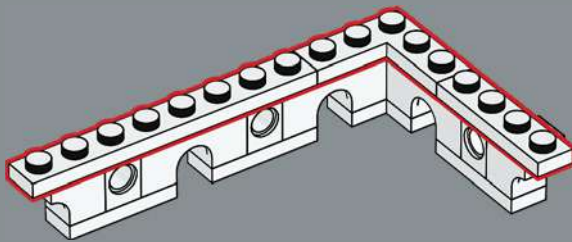




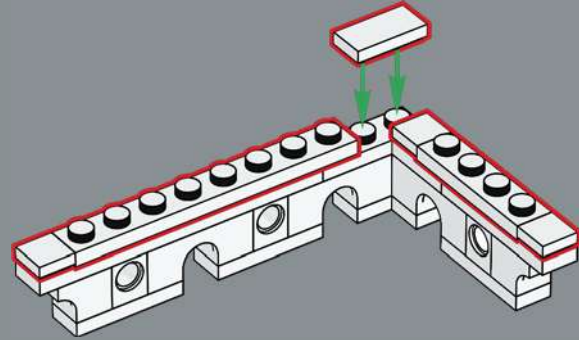
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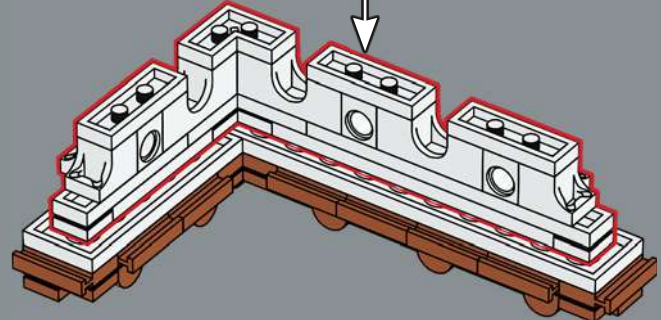
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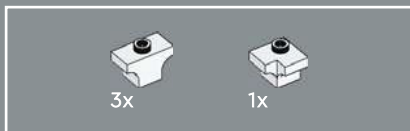


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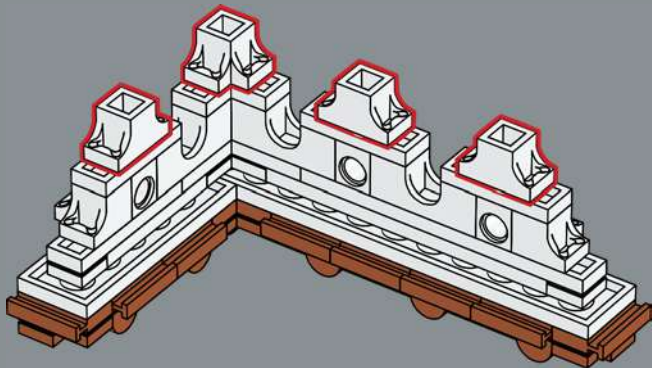


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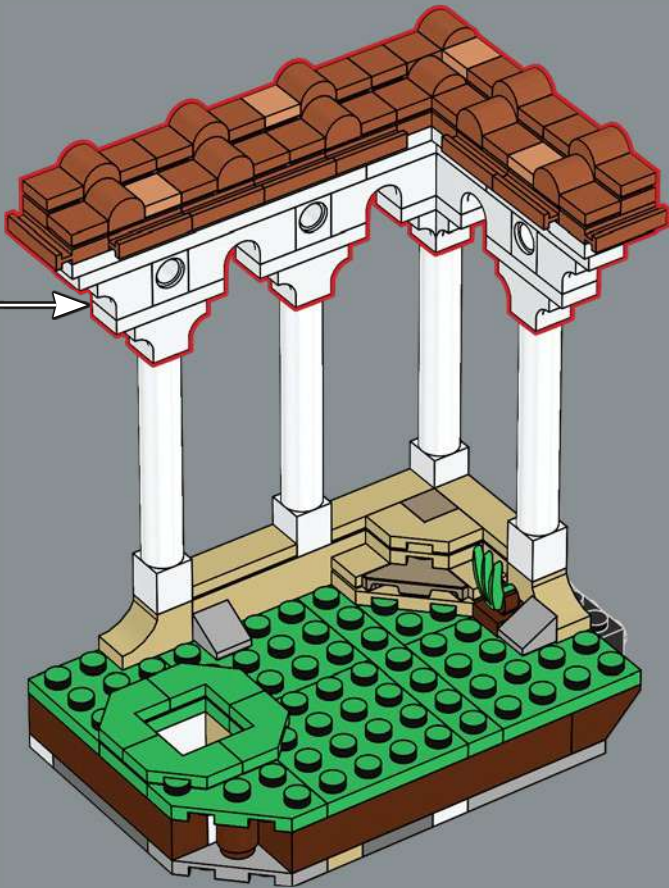


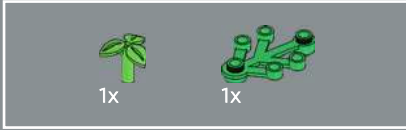
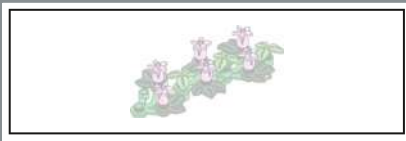


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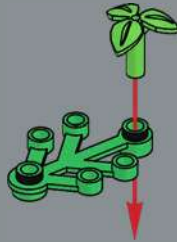


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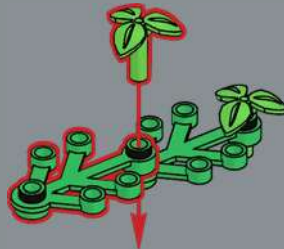




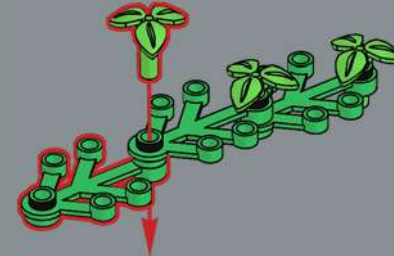
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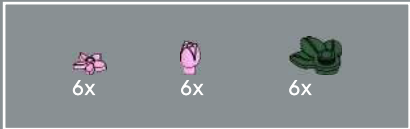


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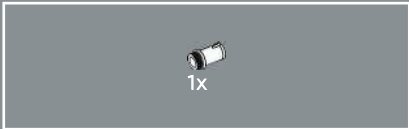
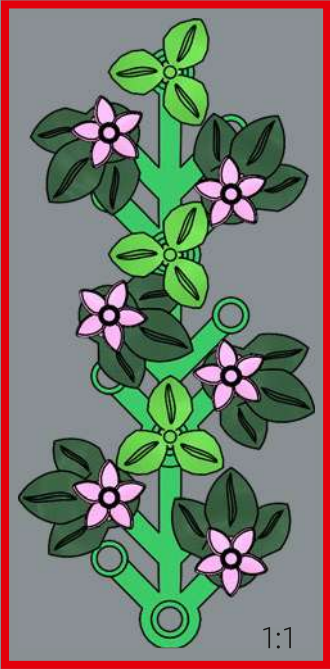
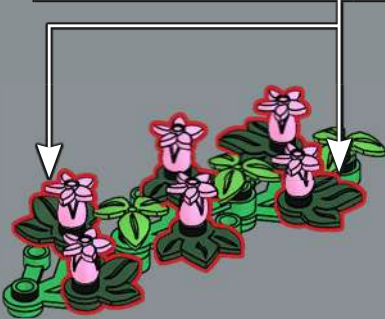
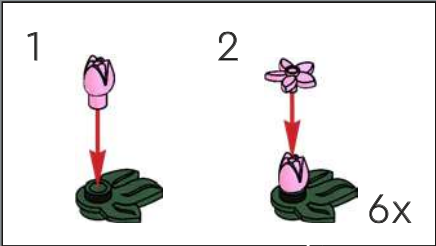


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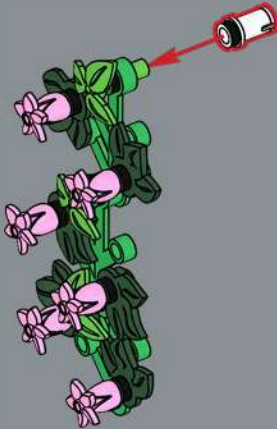




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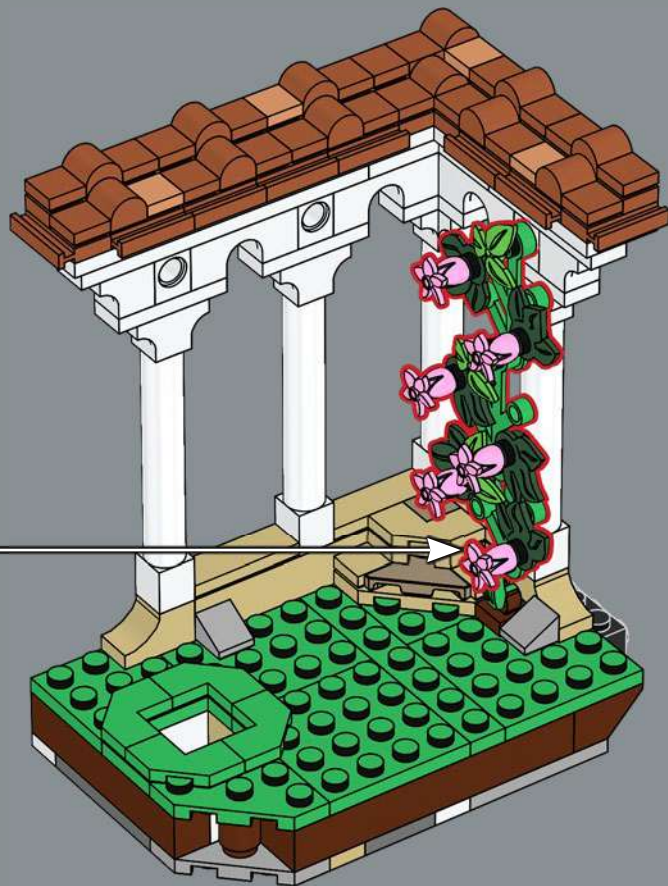


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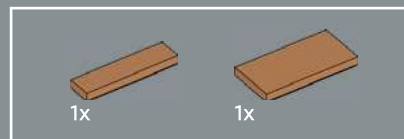


Pink bougainvillea flower (*Bougainvillea*)

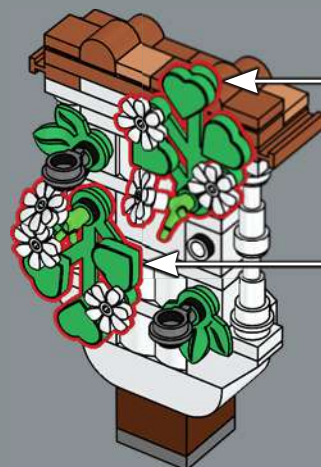
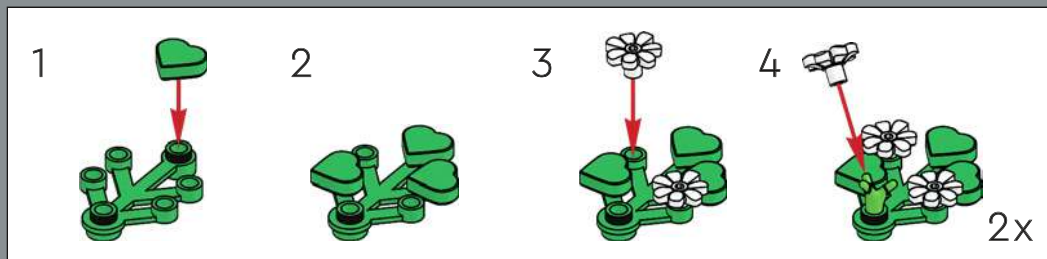
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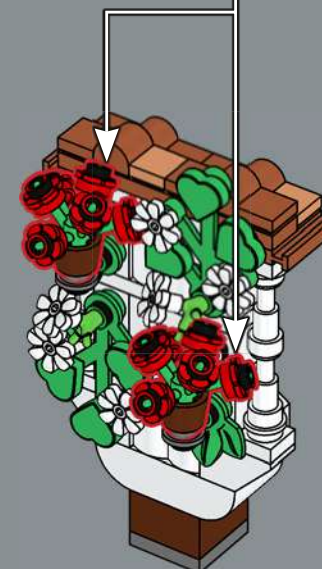
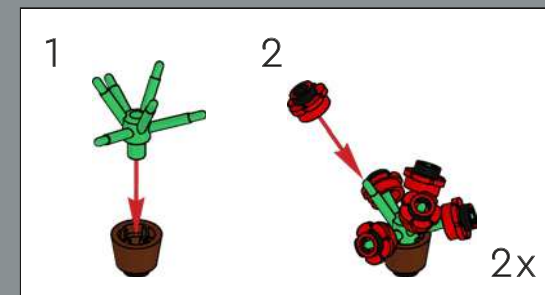


White petunia (*Petunia axillaris*)

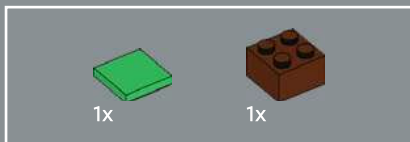


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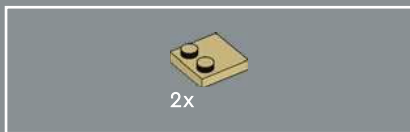
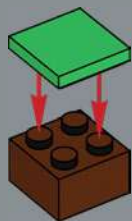


Red garden geranium (*Pelargonium x hortorum*)
The fragrant garden geranium serves both aesthetic and practical purposes in a serene garden. Its natural oils give off a scent that sends insects packing!

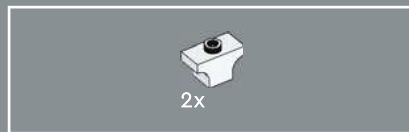
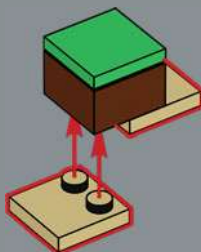




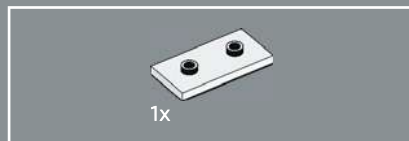
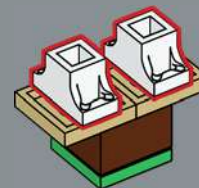

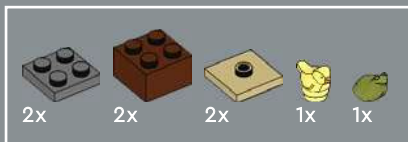




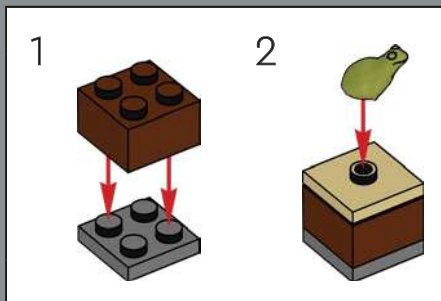
Iberian waterfrog (*Pelophylax perezi*)

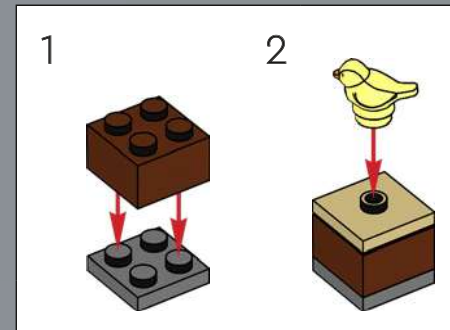


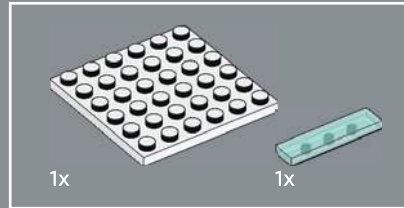
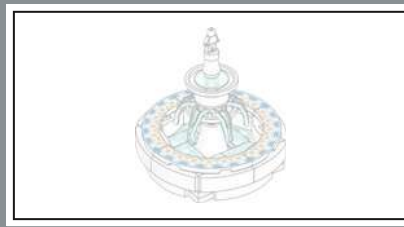


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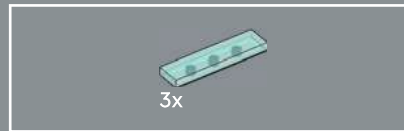
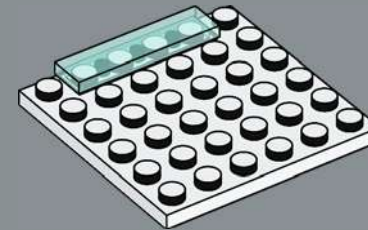


Yellowhammer (*Emberiza citrinella*)
The yellowhammer, with its characteristic bright yellow plumage and distinctive song, is found throughout Europe.

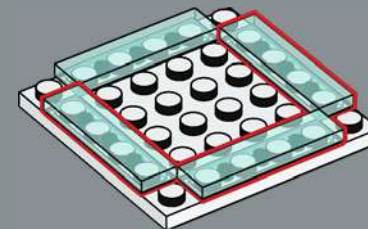




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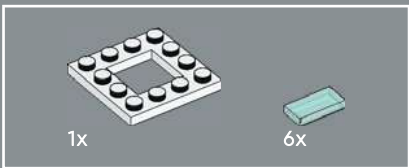
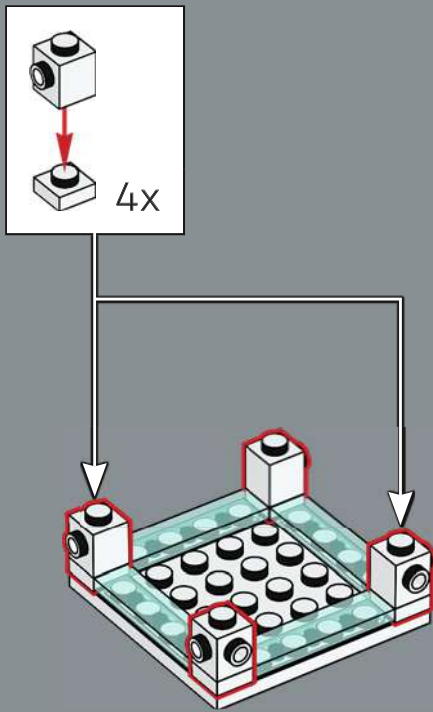


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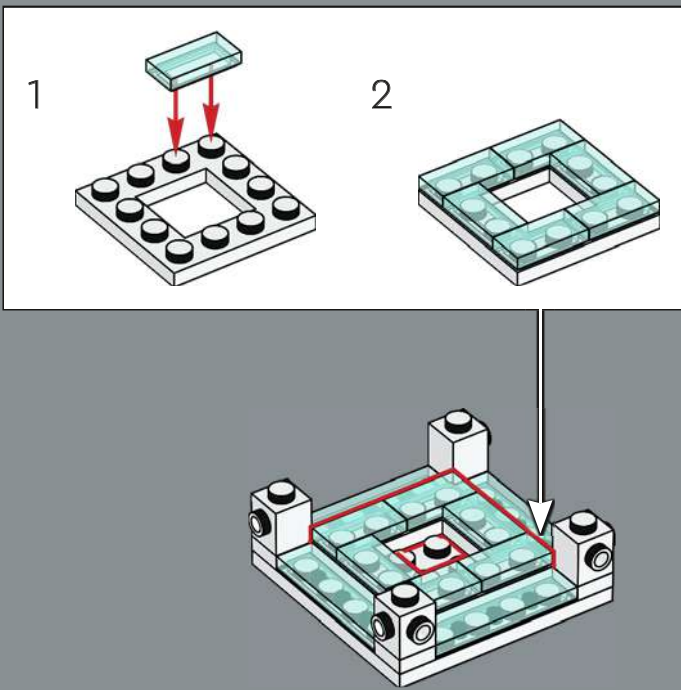


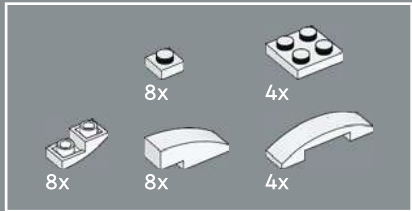
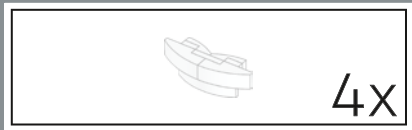


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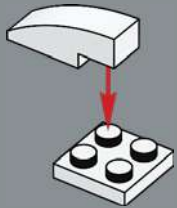
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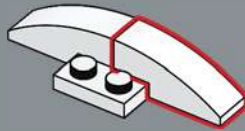


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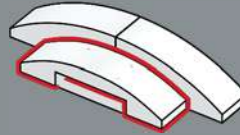
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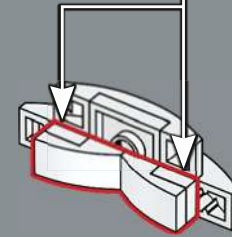
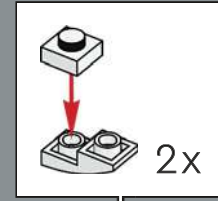
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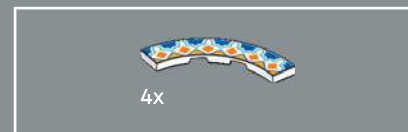
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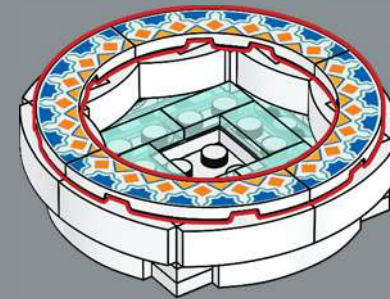
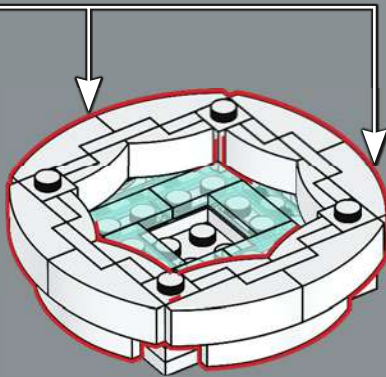
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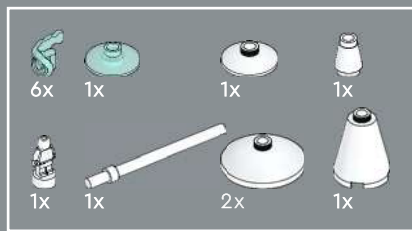


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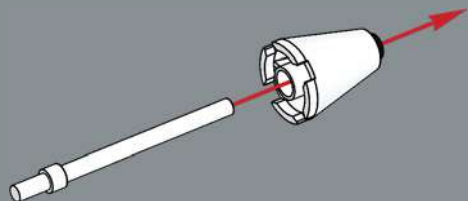

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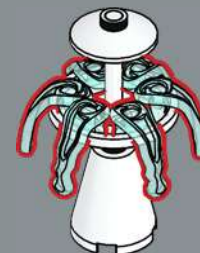
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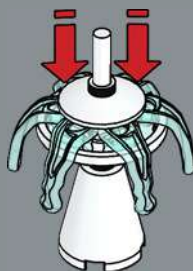
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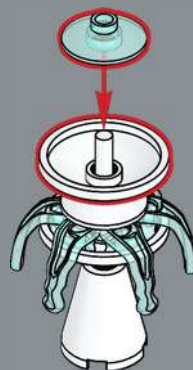
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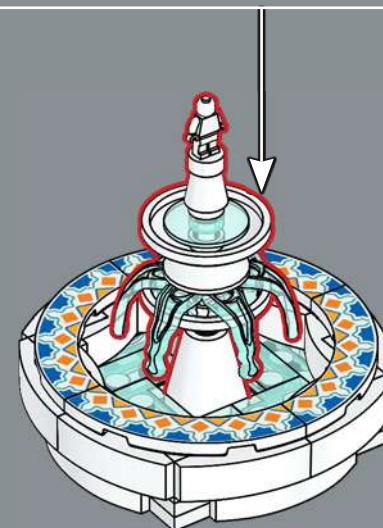
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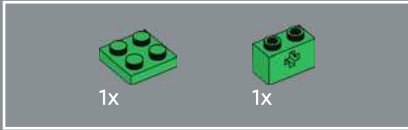
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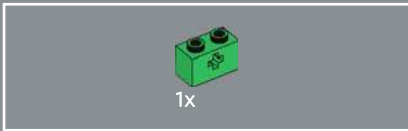
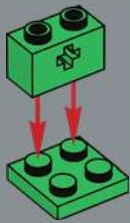
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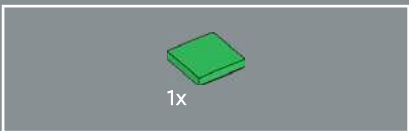




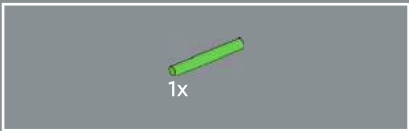
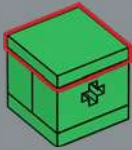
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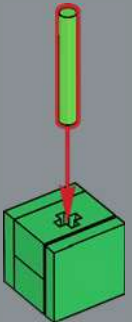
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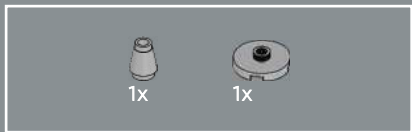


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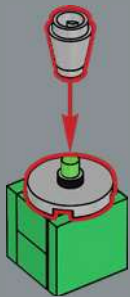


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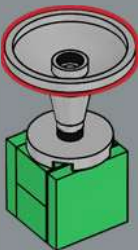




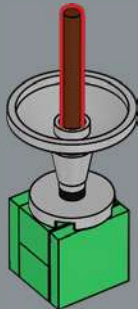
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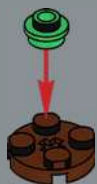
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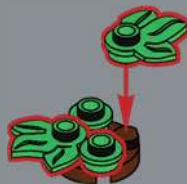


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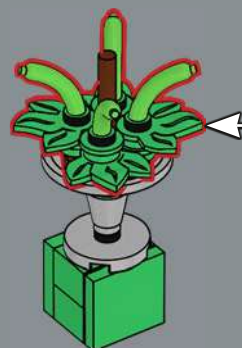
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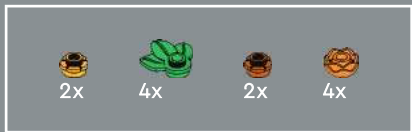


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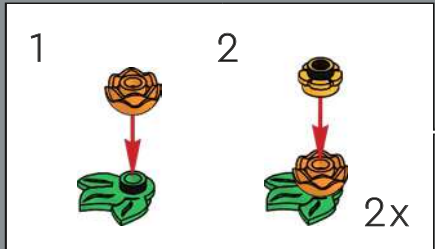
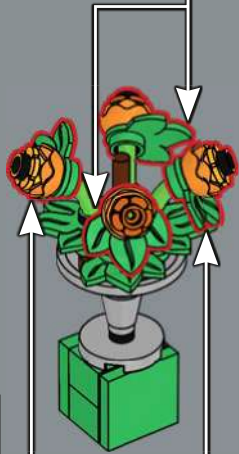
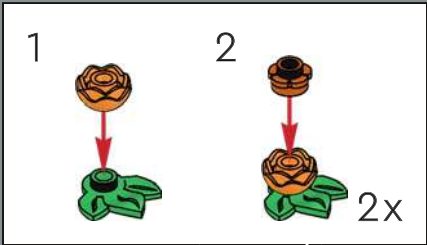


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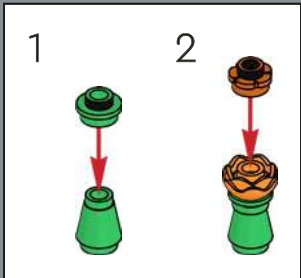




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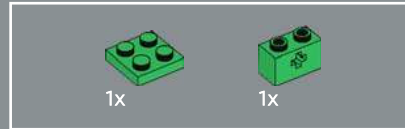
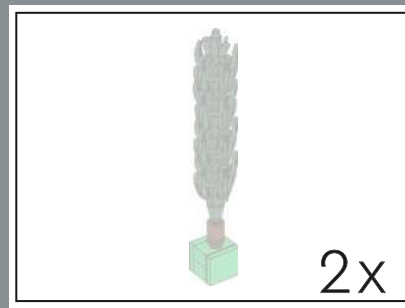
Spanish moon moth (*Graellsia isabellae*)

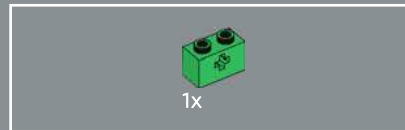
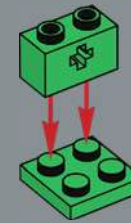


French marigold (*Tagetes patula*)
